I am directed to refer to your application for grant of Continuation of Recognition of MBBS degree (150 seats) awarded by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune, Maharashtra in respect of the students being trained at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College, Pune, Maharashtra and to say that your college was assessed by the Assessors appointed by MARB to conduct virtual assessment during the final MBBS practical Examination on 02 to 03 March, 2022 and physical verification of the facilities on 04th January, 2023. Both the assessment reports were considered in the Undergraduate Medical Education Board, an autonomous Board of the Commission.

2. The above assessment reports alongwith the data available on AEBAS and HMIS including CCTV footage was considered in Under Graduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB) and certain deficiencies were noted. The same were communicated to the college authorities vide UGMEB's letter dated 15.05.2023 for compliance.

3. In response to the above, the Principal, Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) submitted their reply with regard to the deficiencies pointed out by UGMEB in its letter dated 17.05.2023. Subsequently, an opportunity of the personal hearing was also given to the college authorities on 30.05.2023.

4. After hearing the college authorities and careful consideration of the facts and compliance, it has been decided by the UGMEB that Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College, Pune, Maharashtra is granted one year Recognition of MBBS qualification. However, they shall apply afresh for recognition in 2024.


