




NOTIFICATION

- iii) It will adhere to the guidelines / instructions issued by UGC from time to time as applicable to the Deemed Universities.







NOTIFICATION

Whereas the Central Government is empowered under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 to declare, on the advice of the UGC, an institution of higher learning as a deemed-to-be-university;

2. And whereas "Bharati Vidyapeeth", Pune was declared deemed to be a university under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 vide this Ministry's notification No.F.9-15/95-U.3 dated the 26th April, 1996;

3. And whereas, the Bharati Vidyapeeth, in April, 2002, requested the UGC for giving a status of independent constituent unit to (i) Interactive Research School for Health Affairs (IRSHA), Pune and (ii) Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Information Technology and Biotechnology (RGIITBT), Pune, under its ambit. The UGC agreed to bring the said institutions under the ambit of Bharati Vidyapeeth subject to few conditions and later approved this decision in the meeting of the Commission held on 25.09.2002;

4. And whereas, at the instance of this Ministry the UGC has conducted inspection of the institutions mentioned at para 3 above through its Expert Committee and upon considering the inspection report of the Expert Committee the Commission vide its communication F.No.3-2/90(CPP-I) dated 19.05.2008 has approved the recommendations of the Expert Committee to bring IRSHA and RGIITBT under the ambit of Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University, Pune for the conduct of non-professional courses with effect from 17th August, 2002, the date on which the UGC permitted them to be part of the Deemed-to-be-University;

5. Now, therefore, the Central Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, and on the basis of the reports made available by the UGC in the matter, do hereby grant permission to (i) Interactive Research School for Health Affairs (IRSHA), Pune and (ii) Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Information Technology and Biotechnology (RGIITBT), Pune to function as independent constituent units of the Bharati Vidyapeeth, Deemed-to-be-University, Pune, for the purpose of the aforesaid Act, with effect from the 17th August, 2002, the date on which the UGC had permitted them to be part of the Vidyapeeth, subject to fulfillment/compliance of the following conditions that:

- (i) the permission granted to the RGIITBT is for the conduct of non-professional courses only;
- (ii) the permission granted to the IRSHA is not for conduct of any academic courses/programmes, and the IRSHA which is basically a Research Centre shall continue to function so under the ambit of the Bharati Vidyapeeth;
- (iii) all the moveable and immovable assets/properties of the RGIITBT and the IRSHA shall be legally transferred and vested with the Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed-to-be-University);
- (iv) the Bharati Vidyapeeth shall revise/amend its 'Memorandum of Association (MoA) & Rules immediately as per the model MoA/Rules prescribed by the UGC and get them approved by the UGC; and
- (iv) the Bharati Vidyapeeth will adhere to the norms and guidelines prescribed by the UGC from time to time, as are applicable to the institutions declared as deemed-to-be-universities under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956;

6. The declaration made in para 5 above shall be subject to compliance/fulfillment of the further conditions that are mentioned at Sl. No. 6 of the endorsement of this notification.

7. Neither the Government of India nor the UGC shall provide any Plan and Non-Plan grant-in-aid to Bharati Vidyapeeth or any of its constituent units.

- (i) The management of the institutions mentioned at para 5 above (i.e. IRSHA and RGIITBT) shall legally vest with the Society/Trust that is managing the affairs of the Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed-to-be-University.
 - (ii) The academic programmes offered or to be offered at the RGIITBT will conform to the norms and standards prescribed by UGC;
 - (iii) The Bharati Vidyapeeth shall not offer / award, as the case may be, any degrees in respect of the academic courses of the RGIITBT that are not specified by the UGC. It shall also ensure that the nomenclatures of the degrees, etc. to be awarded by it are specified by the UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956.
 - (iv) The Bharati Vidyapeeth shall not conduct any distance education programmes through any of its constituent teaching units without prior approval of the UGC and the Distance Education Council (DEC). The guidelines issued by both the DEC and the UGC from time to time in the matter of imparting education through distance mode shall have to be complied with by it.
 - (v) The Bharati Vidyapeeth shall not start and run any study centre / extension centre / off-campus centre / off-shore campus without obtaining the requisite prior approval of the UGC/ DEC / Government of India, as the case may be.
 - (vi) Any new courses to be started at the RGIITBT shall be done as per the norms and the guidelines of the UGC.
 - (vii) The Trust Deed, MoA/Rules, Regulations & Bye-laws of the Bharati Vidyapeeth should reflect the names of the teaching institutions; including those mentioned in para 5 above, that are integral parts of Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed-to-be-University).
 - (viii) The accounts of the institutions concerned shall be maintained in the name of the 'Deemed-to-be-University' Institution, and shall be open to inspection by the UGC.
 - (ix) There shall be no diversion of assets & funds of the institutions mentioned in para 5 above without prior permission of the UGC.
 - (x) The objectives of the Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed-to-be-University) should confine to educational and related social and charitable activities. The Vidyapeeth as well as its constituent units shall not

engage in any activities that are of commercial and profit-making in nature.

- (xi) The corpus fund of Rs.50 lakh created by the Bharati Vidyapeeth and the Bank Guarantees of Rs.17.65 Crore tendered by the Vidyapeeth for starting various Postgraduate courses shall be irrevocable and should be kept alive.
 - (xii) As and when necessary, the Bharati Vidyapeeth shall update or revise or modify its MoA / Rules with the approval of the UGC. Further, specific changes/amendments, if any, suggested by the Government of India or UGC shall also be carried out in the MoA/Rules with the approval of the UGC.
 - (xiii) The Bharati Vidyapeeth shall maintain infrastructure of the institutions concerned as per the norms and guidelines of the UGC as are applicable to 'Deemed-to-be-Universities'.
 - (xiv) The Bharati Vidyapeeth shall take all the required steps to get the academic courses/programmes of the RGITBT rated for valid accreditation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), etc. in terms of instructions issued by the UGC vide its circular No.F.6-1(7)/2006(CPP-I) dated the 12th March, 2007.
 - (xv) The Bharati Vidyapeeth shall follow and abide by all the undertakings they have already submitted or are going to submit in future to the UGC.
 - (xvi) Suggestions and recommendations as made out by the UGC's Expert Committee in its inspection report should be complied with by the Bharati Vidyapeeth and its constituent unit concerned, so as to rectify the deficiencies and to bring about the recommended improvement at the said institute.
 - (xvii) The Bharati Vidyapeeth and its constituent units concerned shall abide by all the norms and guidelines as laid down by the UGC from time to time, as are applicable to Institutions notified as 'Deemed-to-be-Universities'
