## Code of Research Ethics Interactive Research School for Health Affairs (IRSHA) Bharati Vidyapeeth (deemed to be University), Pune

The Code of Research Ethics has been proposed to maintain and promote IRSHA's reputation for excellence and integrity. Every member of the Institute- regular staff, project staff, technical staff, students, and administrative staff- is expected to follow this code in letter as well as in spirit. The principles stated in this code are in line with laws and regulations of the country, University policies and procedures, contractual and grant obligations, and generally accepted principles of ethical conduct.

1. The applicable guidelines and rules while planning, execution and analysis of the research e.g. ICMR Ethical guidelines for biomedical research should be followed by the researchers.
2. All projects should be presented and approved by the Institutional Research Review Committee.
3. Any research project involving humans or animals should be initiated only after obtaining permission of the Ethics Committee of the respective (Medical/Dental/Ayurveda/Homeopathy) College/Hospital.
4. The terms and conditions of each grant and contract on which an individual is working should be followed meticulously.
5. All records and documentations should be kept accurate and complete. The raw data and source documents need to be retained as per the requirement of the project work.
6. While publication of research work, activities such as misrepresentation, plagiarism, fabrication and falsification of data are strictly prohibited. All projects, theses and manuscripts should be verified for plagiarism using the appropriate software before submission.
7. Every member should adopt the proper procedures and controls in the storage and handling of toxic and hazardous materials including biomedical waste as per the Institutional EHS policy.

In case of any violation observed with respect to the code of Ethics, it should be reported to the Director, IRSHA.
