## Instructions for I MBBS (old curriculum), II MBBS, III MBBS (Part I) and DMLT Students for Return for Final University Examinations scheduled in month of October and November 2020

- The following instructions are issued for students for I MBBS (old curriculum), II MBBS, 1. III MBBS (Part I) and DMLT courses appearing in their final examinations in October and November 2020. The examinations are scheduled to commence from 17 October 2020 as per University Notification available on the university website. All students appearing in the examinations are advised to go through the notification of our University.
- All exam going students are hereby directed to return to Pune on or before 5th of October 2. 2020, keeping in view uncertainties regarding travel and imposition of quarantine by local authorities.
- Students staying in Bharati Vidyapeeth hostels should intimate their date of arrival in 3. advance to the respective hostel wardens. Students staying outside the hostel should intimate their date of arrival in advance to their respective housing societies.
- On arrival at respective places of stay, students are required to intimate their arrival to their 4. mentor faculty mentors will inform Vice Principal Dr. M. D. Karmarkar (Mob: 9822912023) or Professor in Charge UG Affairs and Training Dr. M. K. Padwal (Mob 9822601149).
- All students will observe a period of 10 days quarantine in their place of stay and should not 5. move out of the hostels or their residences during this period.
- In the view of COVID 19 Pandemic, students should follow all norms of social distancing, 6. hand sanitization and use of face masks as prescribed. They should also remain indoors as far as possible and concentrate on preparation for their examinations.
- 7. Reading room in College library may be made available to exam going students only, with strict adherence to social distancing norms, if local conditions permit.
- In case of any signs of illness during the stay or on arrival, students should immediately 8. report to CMO/Flu OPD of Bharati Hospital and Research Centre Pune for further management.
- Students are advised to read the Notices displayed on the website, pertaining to payment of 9. fees. Fees needs to be remitted immediately in order for us to complete and submit examination forms to the university in time.
- Commencement of classes after examinations will be intimated in due course and Students 10. should join the online or offline classes for next semester as per the prevailing COVID19 situation, after the declaration of university results.
