The Central Government may, on the advice of the Commission, declare by notification in the Official Gazette, that any institution for higher education, other than a University, shall be deemed to be a University for the purposes of this Act, and on such a declaration being made, all the provisions of this Act shall apply to such institution as if it were a University within the meaning of clause (f) of section 2.




With reference to your letter No. BYDU:2K:2001:140 dated 15th April, 2002 requesting to include Interactive Research School for Health Affairs and Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Information Technology and Bio-Technology under the ambit of Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University. In this connection, I am directed to inform you that UGC has agreed to your request to bring these two institutions under the ambit of the Bharati Vidyapeeth with the following conditions:

1. The UGC shall review the functioning of these institutions after 3 years and continuance of these institutions with the Bharati Vidyapeeth or otherwise will be decided based on the review.
2. The assets together with the land of these two institutions will be transferred to the Bharati Vidyapeeth and these institutions will be treated as two new faculties of the Bharati Vidyapeeth.
3. The MoA/Rules and Regulations will be so amended to bring in these two additional institutions under the ambit of the Bharati Vidyapeeth.
4. There will be no financial liability, whatsoever, on the part of the UGC for these institutions.

You are requested to kindly send your concurrence of the above conditions.



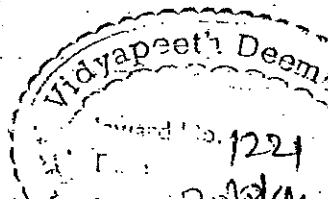

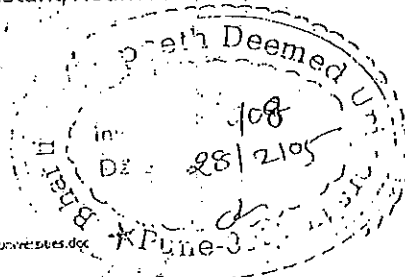
