- c. Person desirous of becoming member of the society shall sign the application form prescribed for the purpose and pay the amount prescribed for category of membership specified in rule 5 and submit the same to President of the society.

5. Types of Members:

Two persons shall be selected as Vice-President. Vice-President shall look after all the activities of the society in absence of President. Vice-Presidents will also help President in various activities.

### Secretary:

In addition to this, the President can call special Executive Council meeting for any special and urgent purpose if found necessary or if the request is made by 15 members in writing.

### 14. Notice & Quorum of Executive Council meeting:

For ordinary meeting of executive council, 14 days notice shall be issued to all the members of executive council with the permission of president either by hand delivery or by post. The notice shall specify the date and place for such meeting and shall state the business to be transacted there

Presence of at least 12 Executive Council members shall form the quorum for the Executive Council. In absence of the quorum meeting can be adjourned half an hour. After half an hour the meeting will be conducted for which quorum is not necessary to transact the business.

The president can call special meeting by giving 2 days notice to transact business of urgent nature.

### 15. Rules for election of Executive Council:

The terms of the Executive Council shall be for two years. One month notice shall be sent to all the members regarding election. Application forms in prescribed format invited from those who are willing to be come members of executive council. For the election there shall be one person for recommendation & one person for secondation. The election shall be held by ballot paper. The ballot paper shall be sent to all members through post. Members shall select Executive Council members through preferential voting procedure.

### 16. Filling up Vacancies in Managing Committee:

If any vacancy, except President arises due to death, removal, resignation or otherwise then the same shall be filled up by majority of remaining Members of the Executive Council for the remaining period & such , change shall be submitted before Honorable Assistant Charity Commissioner, Pune.

#### 17. Rights & duties of the Executive Council:

- a. To consider applications for admissions of membership as per rules of the society.
- b. To accept or to reject donations, subscriptions, financial aid or any property on any terms & conditions agreed by it.
- c. To arrange for proper maintenance of accounts & preparation of balance sheets, statements etc. and submission of progress report & other obligatory returns to concerned authorities.

To sanction fees of the auditor & put audit report before the Executive Council.

### 18. Funds & Income of society and disposition of society:

Funds for the society can be raised through subscription, donations, loans with or without interest, funds for the society can be raised through grants from Government, semi Government and any other method approved by the Executive Council. The society may create funds for specific purpose & collect donations, the society or specific purpose.

19. Provisions for expenses of the society:

All expenses will be carried out with prior approval of President and Executive council.

20. Provisions for loans & deposits:

For furtherance of all or any of the objects, the society shall have with the prior permission required under section 35 & section 36 of the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950 authorizing to borrow and raise money with or without security, mortgage or pledge to accept deposits. Prior to this that written permission of joint charity commissioner, Pune region, Pune shall be taken as laid down in the B.P.T. Act 1950.

21. Provision for purchasing immovable property & deposition of property:

Executive Council has rights to accept, purchase any movable or immovable property, subject to rules and regulations. Executive Council has right to maintain sales, manage, transfer, lease or layout or otherwise dispose off any property of the society. Prior to this, written permission of Joint Charity Commissioner shall be taken as per B.P.T. Act 1950 according to section 36.

### 22. Blank Accounts:

The Society may open blank account in any nationalized, scheduled or any approved co-operative bank or post office. The Bank account shall be operated with the sign of either President & Secretary or President & Treasurer.

### 23. List of Members:

The list of members shall be kept as per provision of society registration act, 1860 & rules 15 of Maharashtra rules 1971 in Sch. VI. Society registration act 1860 & rule 4 of Maharastra rules 1971 & as per Rule 7, schedule. Every year list of Executive Council shall be sent to Honorable Assistant Charity Commissioner or to Charity Commissioner or to Charity Commissioner Office, Pune, Pune Region.

#### WEBINAR: IMPACT OF COVID ON THE HOSPITALITY INDUSTRY

Date: 31st Aug 2020, 11 am

The hospitality industry has been greatly impacted by Covid 19 and the plans of Industry Exposure and Placements of the Hotel Management students have been put on hold.

To address the uncertainty surrounding Industry Exposure for SY BSc (H&HA) students who were scheduled to commence their Industry Exposure from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020, the Training & Placement Cell of the institute organized a Webinar – "Impact of Covid on the hospitality industry" by Mr.Virender Choudhary.

Dr.S.A.Sangle, Training &Placement Officer with great pleasure and pride introduced Mr. Virender Choudhary General Manager, Ibis Pune Hinjewadi, and also as an alumni who has done the institute proud.

Mr.Virender Choudhary expressed his immense pleasure to be addressing the students of his almamater and recalled the wonderful times spent at the institute and the support and guidance received from the teachers.

He shared his professional journey of working in the hospitality industry for the last 12years and his association for nearly 10 years with Accor in India with a versatile exposure of working with its brands & hotels (Ibis, Formulae One) in cities like Pune, Ahmedabad and Nashik; along with short stint at Accor India corporate office as National Operations Manager supervising the operations of 10 budget segment hotels in 7 cities.

He appreciated the strong foundation laid by the teachers of the institute and his belief in Accor values & culture which has being the reason for the success till date.

Coming to the topic he discussed his company's deep committment to preventing the spread of COVID-19 – by partnering with top experts, investing in research, new standards of safety, enhanced protocols and procedures which will address the new reality.

He informed about the launch of the ALLSAFE label, which represents some of the most stringent cleaning standards & operational procedures in the hospitality industry developed with and vetted by Bureau Veritas, a world leader in testing, inspections and certification.

He started with discussing the general measures undertaken at the hotel:

- Physical distancing
- Hand hygiene, including proper hand washing & hand sanitizer stations
- Mandatory screening for all guests and employees, which may include a temperature check
- Face coverings mandated for all employees and guests in all indoor public spaces
- Increased cleaning & disinfecting frequency, with continued use of EPA-registered disinfecting chemicals, proven effective in preventing the transmission of COVID-19

- COVID-19 awareness, education & training
- Formal cleaning & disinfecting audit program

Mr. Choudhary discussed in detail the specific measures adopted during Arrival, Welcome & Check in, and during Check out. Department specific measures adopted by Housekeeping, F&B ( particularly restaurants, in room dining and kitchen ) were discussed.

He discussed the challenges faced by the hotel during the initial days of lockdown when delivery of vegetables, fruits and other requirements were affected, staff having to stay at the hotel and many more overwhelming situations and how they all together overcame it.

He pointed out that though the industry has been badly hit, but his hotel has already surpassed the annual target by catering to the guests of Vande Bharat Mission.

He agreed that that returning to normalcy will take time, may be another year...most hotels may not take interns since there is no business and are worried about the safety of the interns. Even if hotels do take interns the numbers will be greatly reduced.

He suggested that students should engage themselves with online courses, access online material relevant to hotel operations until hotels are ready to welcome interns. He also suggested working with restaurants as an alternative.

The session was followed by Question and Answer session. Mr.Virender Choudhary very patiently answered all the queries and offered valuable career guidance to the students.

The speaker guided the students on pursuing a successful career in the hospitality industry. He advised the students to follow their passion and dreams which will lead to a successful career.







# A STUDENT MEMBER:

A student member is one who is a final year undergraduate or post graduate student of ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE and who pays an annual contribution of Rs. 100/for such membership. The student member shall not have any voting right and representation whatsoever in Governing body of the society.

# e) HONORARY MEMBER:

The associations by the resolution of the Governing Body cite HONRARY MEMBERSHIP to an outstanding faculty or any other outstanding person, who otherwise cannot be enrolled as a member. The citation could be made by the Governing body to much person. Honorary Member has no voting right nor can be hold any post as the office bearer

#### 6. DISQUALFICATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

- (1) The 'General Body Unanimously Shall have power to remote a member if he is found acting prejudicially to the interest, prestige and working of the ALUMNI. However, sufficient opportunity shall be given to him to submit his explanation within 15 days. And if such explanation is not found satisfactory to the committee his/her membership shall cancelled.
- (2) If a Member Resigns his membership in writing and his registration is so accepted by the General Body.
- (3) If a member does not pay his membership fee as decided by 'General Body for a continuous period of 3 months his membership will be automatically cancelled however in case if the member pays dues then the 'General Body can allow him membership from the earlier date.

- b. The members of Governing Body shall ordinarily hold office for a period of three and shall retire at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting held next after the financial year in which the above said period of three year has expired.
- c. A member of Governing Body, of ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE resigns from the membership of the Governing Body by giving a notice to the president in writing of his/her intention can to do so. The president would convene a meeting.
- d. Governing Body can request one of the other office bearers to chair and then alone to could tender his/her registration a new member should be elected in this meeting. This is of course under special our ordinary circumstances.
- e. Within 21 days from receipt of the notice of resignation from a member the president shall accept the resignation after ensuring that pending matters, if any, concerning his membership of Governing Body properly discharged.

- f. All questions at a meeting a Governing Body shall be decided by a majority of votes and in case of an equality of votes, of the chairman shall have casting vote.
- g. A declaration by the chairman that resolution has been carried or not and an entry of that in books of proceeding of the Governing Body of ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE shall be conclusive evidence of that fact.
- h. business by circulars: Any business in which it may be necessary for the Governing Body to transact (except such as may be placed before its annual meeting) may be transacted by circulation and approved by two third of members signing the circular shall be as effectual and binding as if such Resolutions had passed in a meeting of Governing Body.
- Proceedings of all meeting of Governing Body shall be duly recorded in the minute's book to be kept for the purpose.

- VII. To enter into agreement for and on behalf of ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE
- VIII. To sue and defend all legal proceedings on behalf ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE
- IX. To grant receipts, sign and execute instruments and to endorse discount cheques or negotiable instrument directly or through accredited agents.
- X. To make, sign and execute all such documents and instruments as may be necessary or proper for carrying management of the property or affairs ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE and to draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange and other negotiable

XIII. To make suitable grant or donations of money or other assistance to a university, educational institution or other society for conducting or the persuasion of any research or charity investigation or study in a subject in which ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE is interested.

XIV. To use funds and assets of ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE in the employment of persons and use of buildings and instruments, material and appliances and any of the assets of ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE or scientific, industrial and management research and such other purposes.

XV. To grant fellowship, scholarship or the monetary assistance on terms and conditions to the past and present students of ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE

XVI. To manage, sell, transfer or otherwise dispose of any property, movable or immovable of ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF BHARATI VIDYAPEETH'S (Deemed to be University) COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, PUNE

XVII. To assign from time to time such functions and duties and delegate such Powers, as it may deem fit, to any person or persons or members of the Subcommittees, to grant travel expenses and other out of pocket expenses incurred by them in the performance of their functions.

XXIII. To create new and abolish existing post paid or otherwise and to appoint suspend, remove any employee in the office, award any punishment, sanction any promotion or demotions, direct transfer, retirements grants leave, grant extension in office and/or in service.



# 17. CHANGE IN RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Any change to be done in the rules and regulations will be done by calling special General Body Meeting and 3/5th of the total number of members should be present for the said meeting and the said change should be accepted in the said meeting by majority; a copy of proposed change(s) in Rules and Regulations shall be sent along-with Notice to the members well in advance.

Any amendment to the Rules and Regulation will be carried out only with the approval of Asstt. Registrar of Societies, Pune and Asstt.Charity commissioner, Pune. The same shall be informed to the Competent Income Tax Authority i.e. Commissioner of Income Tax, Pune, for the purpose of Section 12A of the income Tax act.

## 18. LIST OF MEMBERS:

The list of persons who are members within the meaning of Section 15 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, shall be maintained in the form of Schedule VI to the Societies Registration (Maharashtra) Rules, 1971 vide Rules 15 thereof.

# 19. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:

a. 

- 6. **Progression of All sorts** We should all be ready to Change our career. Horizontal Progression is a big key. New Area of Expertise is always appreciated Last but not the least Happiness Is also a key. You should be more than content with what you do and how you do it.

## Inputs by Mr. Sandip Bhansali-

Mr.Bhansali did his MBA in 2009 and started off his career with a Brokerage firm. He spoke about his journey In the early days and How He ended up at TCS . He had several inputs for the students. Some of them are as follows-

#### 1. Flexibility is necessary -

In order to grow you should not fear flexibility. He used his own example how He shifted to Chennai to grow his career in financial reporting

- 2. In Today's world **IT Domain knowledge** is of highest importance
- 3. Importance of familiarity with the corporate world and how should we enhance it by contestant learning which is only possibly through news reading and getting familiar with new Jargons of The corporate world.
- 4. Data Analysis as the new Big step: The importance of IT resources like SQL and Database even the Cloud data bases are the new basis for further development In the industry. He further related these database system to revenue path of marketing and how Finance domain Looks after the sheer health of The company.
- 5. Importance of Case Study: Mr Bhansali Insisted upon how a budding mind in corporate world Can have a head start over others if he/ she is a constant learner and has a interest in the Case studies of various successful firms and unsuccessful ones also. He used the example of The Bankruptcy of YES bank to illustrate the importance of case studies.

He ended his note on an optimistic note on how the Industry will soon be back to it's peak.

QUESTION AND ANSWER ROUND –(Some of the Questions put up by the students)

### Q1. What are the industry expectations for a Analyst beginner nd what are the preparations required for it?

**Answer** - This was answered by Mr Sandip Bhansali. He told how in Finance Domain there are some skills set of utmost Importance. They are

- 1. Ratio Calculations
- 2. Ratio Analysis and In the domain of financial reporting you have to know the basics of PNL , Balance sheet and Cashflow. You have to know the items you are reporting.

#### Q2. Has working culture changed due to COVID-19 Situation?

Answer- This Was answered by Mr Sujit. He described how there is a permanent change in the working culture and how an Hybrid System has evolved in a place of a traditional system. 100% people are never there rather there 60-70 % only even after the effects got ever. Multifaceted people are of much more importance now for better coordination. He further stressed how the boundaries have become vague now. Timing is not of importance. Now you could deliver your work even after the business Hours.

#### Q3. Is there any change in Supply chain and logistics Domain?

**Answe**r- This Was Answered By Mr Gami. He told how back end part of the business that is finance and reporting has taken a back seat and it's shifted to online basis. He further told how Field Job is not a necessity anymore. He ended up by telling how logistics has grown over the time in the COVID how it became much more efficient.

#### **Description:**

The welcome address of the webinar on "Model View Controller (MVC)" given by respected Dr. S. B. Sawant Sir, Director AKIMSS. The webinar session inaugurated by Dr. A. B. Nadaf sir HOD, AKIMSS. The preamble given by Dr. M. K. Patil, MCA Coordinator, AKIMSS.

Dr. M. K. Patil started the session by giving the basic overview of MVC architecture and its applications.

The expert Mr. Rajesh Vhadlure explained the concept of Model View Controller (MVC) in detail. In his session he highlighted following points:

#### 1) Concept of MVC

ASP.NET MVC is a new web application framework from Microsoft. MVC stands for Model-View-Controller. ASP.NET MVC is an open source web development framework from Microsoft that provides a Model View Controller architecture. ASP.net MVC offers an alternative to ASP.net web forms for building web applications. It is a part of the .Net platform for building, deploying and running web apps. You can develop web apps and website with the help of HTML, CSS, jQuery, Javascript, etc

#### 2) Architecture of MVC

Model - The Model represents a set of classes that describe the business logic i.e. business model as well as data access operations i.e. data model. It also defines business rules for data means how the data can be changed and manipulated.

View - The View represents the UI components like CSS, jQuery, html etc. It is only responsible for displaying the data that is received from the controller as the result. This also transforms the model(s) into UI.


Controller - The Controller is responsible to process incoming requests. It receives input from users via the View, then processes the user's data with the help of Model and passes the results back to the View. Typically, it acts as the coordinator between the View and the Model.

- If you are developing parallel MVC application, then sometimes it becomes difficult to coordination between other developers. Because all developers have to in the same page.







Then Rupal shared her experience that is very kept in the media domain so she got placed in life link movies with the help of the college she faced problems in the organization so she shifted to the education sector where she started as BDM and HR both. They both entered in their desired fields but they worked in the same domains as their skills were suitable for that domain they are currently working for. When we want to change the domain, we have to try and change the domain within the company then we will get a better opportunity. And if we try to change it with a new company then the chances are 4% to 5% only. It is easier in the company to switch the domains as our boss knows that we are performing the task in the company for a long time and we are performing well over there, then we can ask the manager or the boss to switch the domains as we cannot see any growth in the graph in this domain. And if you are good at your job then the company cannot afford to lose a good employee at this time. If we want to switch the domain then we need to do our homework and should have all the knowledge about the skills required and the domain as well. And then in the future we would be at an advantage because the company looks for the candidates who have experience in multiple fields. For any domain our Excel and PowerPoint should be perfect.






