The students of the College have participated and won several international and national moot court competitions during last 9 years. The College has recently conducted Justice P.N. Bhagwati 9th International Moot Court Competition on Human Rights wherein 14 international and 30 national teams from top law schools participated. The competition was inaugurated by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dipak Misra, Chief Justice of India through video conferencing in the presence of Hon'ble Mr. Justice S.K. Kaul, Judge, Supreme Court of India. The College has also signed MoU with Surana & Surana international Attorneys and conducted a unique National Trial Advocacy Moot Court & Judgment Writing Competition on Criminal Law.

#### **CONTINUOUS LEGAL EDUCATION PROGRAMMES**

The College in collaboration with International Bar Association (IBA) & MILAT organizes continuous Legal Education programmes wherein free training is provided to young lawyers, judges, police personnel and teachers for their professional career advancement.

#### **RESEARCH CENTRES:**

The College is recognized by UGC under 2f & 12 (B) of the UGC Act for research and development grants. The College has Indo-European Legal Study &International Research Centre and also International IPR Research Centre. This College publishes Bharati Law Journal (ISSN: 2278-6996) which is a UGC approved Law Journal. The faculty has published more than 397 articles in reputed national and international journals and 21 Books. Minor and Major Research Projects are also undertaken.

#### **LEGAL AID:**

The College has Legal Aid Cell which is administered by senior advocates from Supreme Court and High Courts. The Legal Aid Clinic of College has resolved 872 cases successfully.

It provides free legal aid to the needy and poor persons who seek social justice. Students are encouraged to participate in Lok-Adalats, Legal Aid Camps, Legal Aid Clinics and community service programmes. The College has established special Family Legal Aid Cell to help women and children.

#### OTHER ACTIVITIES:

To enhance the professional skills of the students, the Law College conducts All India Bar Examination training programmes, judicial services training programmes, mock-parliament, intra-collegiate moot court competitions, essay competitions, workshops, seminars, research projects and NSS activities. Sports and Cultural facilities are adequately provided.



## PROCEDURE AND RULES FOR ADMISSION

## 1 ENTRANCE TEST - GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Combined All India PG Law Entrance Test, 2025 is a ranking examination for admission to LL.M Two Year Programme for 2025-26 academic session.
- 1.2 Applicant may kindly note that mere appearance in the Entrance test and inclusion of name in the merit list does not confer any automatic rights to secure admission to the programme offered by the institute. The selection and admission to the programme is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, any such criteria as may be prescribed by the University and availability of seats to the particular programme and institute at the time of counselling.
- 1.3 Applications of Candidates producing false or fabricated information will not be considered.
- 1.4 Before initiating registration process, candidates should go through the information brochure carefully for eligibility criteria, and pattern of examination etc. The information brochure shall be available at- www.bvuniversity.edu.in
- 1.5 Incomplete online application, if not in accordance with instructions, will not be considered and processed. Applicant should carefully fill up all the fields during online application process and complete the payment process. Application once submitted finally, cannot be withdrawn/modified.
- 1.6 The Entrance fee, once paid, will not be refunded under any circumstances. Candidates who remain absent for the Entrance test will forfeit their Entrance Test Fee.
- 1.7 The Information brochure is subject to modification without notice, please check the website regularly for updations, if any.
- 1.8 The authorities of the institution reserves the right to withdraw permission, if any, granted inadvertently to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the Entrance Test even though Admit Card/Registration number has been issued.

- 1.9. The Admissions provided to candidates based on the result of the Entrance Test will be purely provisional and subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as mentioned in the information brochure.
- 1.10. Under no Circumstances a change in the examination centre once selected by the Candidate will be allowed.

#### RAGGING


- Ragging in any form is prohibited and is an offence governed by Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999 and UGC Regulations 2016.
- Ragging within or outside educational institution is prohibited and is an offence.
- $^{\circ}$  Punishment for ragging is imprisonment up to 2 years & / or fine up to Rs. 10,000/-. Student convicted of offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the college and will not be eligible for admission in any other educational institution for a period of 5 years.

#### **HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION**

Limited hostel accommodation is available on the campus both for boys and girls (10 seats for boys & 5 seats for girls). The same will be given on merit basis. The hostel fee once paid is not refundable.




