## SCHOOL OF AUDIOLOGY & SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

Audiology and Speech Language Pathology is an upcoming field in allied health sciences. There is a dearth of Speech Language Pathologists and Audiologists in India as very few colleges provide educational facilities in this field. Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) decided to fulfill this long-standing deficiency in Maharashtra by starting a School of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (SASLP) in the educational capital, the city of Pune under the faculty of health sciences in August 2006. SASLP is located at the Dhankawadi Campus of Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University).

### ABOUT AUDIOLOGY AND SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

Audiology is a branch of science that deals with hearing and hearing related disorders. Students of Audiology are educated regarding the anatomy and physiology of the normal and abnormal auditory system. They are trained in identification and differential diagnosis of auditory disorders. These include disorders of the middle ear, inner ear, auditory nerve and the central auditory nervous system. With training, students develop expertise in audiological rehabilitation, which includes recommendation of hearing devices including hearing aids and cochlear implants. They also learn about assessment and management of individuals with tinnitus, vestibular disorders and auditory processing disorders.

Speech and Language Pathology deals with the normal and abnormal aspects of voice, speech, language, cognition and swallowing. Students of Speech Language Pathology are trained in diagnosis, differential diagnosis and management of speech and language, cognitive communicative disorders, which includes voice disorders, speech sound disorders, stuttering, speech and language problems associated with hearing impairment, intellectual disability, cerebral palsy, 'Cleft lip & Palate', autism spectrum disorders, oral and laryngeal cancers, stroke/ paralysis, and learning disorders.

## ACTIVITIES OF THE SCHOOL OF AUDIOLOGY AND SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

### ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

The college conducts an undergraduate program, Bachelors in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (B.ASLP), a four years course; two post graduate programs - Master of Science (Audiology) and Master of Science (Speech Language Pathology) and two doctoral programs- Ph.D. (Audiology) and Ph.D. (Speech Language Pathology).

The highlights of the academic program are as follows:

- ▶ The courses are affiliated to Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) and are recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI).
- ▶ Infrastructure at the college includes classrooms and seminar halls with facility for audiovisual presentation through smart boards
- ▶ The teaching program is conducted by qualified and experienced faculty with an equal focus on theory, practicals, clinics and research.
- ▶ Guest lectures by experts in the field are arranged regularly to broaden the horizons and promote exchange of information.
- ▶ The college has a well-stocked library with books and scientific journals. New books and journals are added regularly.
- ▶ The staff of the college carry out orientation programs for allied professionals, which include surgeons, general practitioners, special educators, psychologist, teachers of the normal schools and special schools for children with communication disorders special educators, psychologistetc.
- ▶ Workshops/ Seminars/ Symposia are conducted to orient the students on recent advances in the field and to update the knowledge of the professionals in the field.
- ▶ Academic activities of the college include clinical case conferences and journal clubs to orient the students to the basics of research.
- ▶ Students present scientific papers at conferences under the guidance of the faculty.

## CLINICAL SERVICES AVAILABLE AT THE COLLEGE

The college has state of the art facilities for the evaluation and rehabilitation of individuals with speech, language, cognitive, balance and hearing disorders. Besides the college, these services are offered at the Department of ENT and the Department of Pediatrics of the Bharati Hospital and Research Centre. Bedside Assessments/Neonatal Intensive Care Unit/Pediatric Intensive Care Unit /High Risk OPD and management is carried out in wards of Bharati Hospital and Research Centre for individuals with speech & language disorders, oral and pharyngeal cancers, voice OPD, swallowing disorders and vestibular disorders. Camps are conducted at schools for children with communication disorders and in rural areas. School screening programs are conducted to identify children with speech, language, literacy and hearing problems.

### AUDIOLOGY

- ▶ Newborn hearing screening, school screening for hearing and Central Auditory Processing Disorders (CAPD) as well as bedside audio vestibular screening.
- ▶ Assessment and differential diagnosis of auditory disorders, which includes facilities such as pure-tone audiometry, speech audiometry, glycerol test, immittance evaluation, recording of Auditory Evoked Potentials (ABR/ BERA, MLR, LLR, MMN, P300), Auditory Steady State Response (ASSR) and Otoacoustic Emissions (OAE).
- ▶ Selection of hearing aids and other assistive listening devices using objective evaluation tools like Long Latency Responses (LLR) and insertion gain.
- ▶ Selection of candidates for cochlear implants, intra operative monitoring and post implant mapping
- ▶ Post cochlear implant Rehabilitation.
- ▶ Rehabilitation/ Habilitation of individuals with hearing impairment.
- ▶ Assessment and management of individuals with Central Auditory Processing Disorders (CAPD)
- ▶ Assessment and management of individuals with tinnitus and hyperacusis.
- ▶ Assessment and differential diagnosis of different vestibular disorders.

### **THE PROGRAM - BACHELOR IN AUDIOLOGY AND SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY (B.ASLP)**

This is a full-time four-year program including one year of internship. The University has kept an excellent balance between theoretical and clinical training so as to develop both professional judgment and scientific competence in the trained audiologist and speech language pathologist. Throughout the course work, the emphasis is on the development of clinical and research skills. For practical orientation and training the students are posted in various departments of the School of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology and Bharati Hospital Research Centre. The course work has an integrated inter disciplinary content with relevant aspects of anatomy, physiology, otolaryngology, pediatrics, neurology, acoustics and electronics, linguistics, psychology, statistics and research method. In the fourth year, the students are posted at various hospitals, institutions and specialized centers for internship.

## PROCEDURE AND RULES FOR ADMISSION

### 1. GENERAL

The information and the rules given herein are applicable for admissions to the first year of four years full time Bachelor of Audiology & Speech Language Pathology (B.ASLP) undergraduate degree programme of Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune.

The seats will be filled on merit, based on their performance in **ABOP-2025** entrance test", conducted by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) at the designated centers.

#### INTAKE CAPACITY:

Course	Bachelor of Audiology & Speech Language Pathology (B.ASLP)
Total Seats	30

Ten percent (10%) supernumerary seats of over and above the sanctioned intake are reserved for NRI/Foreign quota, candidates from Andaman and Nicobar, Lakshwadeep and Northeast and Jammu and Kashmir. Candidates desirous of getting admission under this category will have to apply separately on a prescribed application form. The application form is available at the Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University). Bharati Vidyapeeth Bhavan, LBS Marg, Pune – 30. **The form fee for this category is Rs. 1,000/- (non refundable).** The last date for submission of application form to this category at the above mentioned address is **09th June 2025** for the entrance test.

Only those candidates who would satisfy all the eligibility requirements as mentioned below will be considered eligible to appear in the entrance test and for admission to the programme.

All the candidates seeking admissions (except NRI or Foreign candidate) will have to appear for Entrance Test **ABOP-2025** conducted by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune. ### 2 ELIGIBILITY

Admission to First year B.ASLP is through **ABOP-2025**

Only those candidates who satisfy or are likely to satisfy the relevant eligibility requirements for admission to the programme will be considered eligible to appear for the entrance and subsequently for admission to the course.

Eligibility requirements for Entrance **ABOP-2025** and subsequent admission to B.ASLP

are as follows:

a	Candidates seeking admission to the B.ASLP program should have passed 10+2 examination or an equivalent examination conducted by the Pre University Board of Education or an equivalent Board of State or Central Government securing a minimum of 50% marks.
b	The applicants/candidates should have studied any two or more subjects in the science stream in the qualifying examination The subjects include Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics
c	In general, admission of students under 'Disability Category' for the BASLP Program shall be governed by the same guidelines (No.U. 14021-8-2023- UGMEB/ Dated 12th June 2023) issued by the National Medical Commission for admission of students under "Disability Category" to the MBBS Program.
d	The eligibility of persons with disability shall be assessed by a committee consisting of an expert in speech-language pathology, audiology, clinical psychology, pediatrics, and otolaryngology, among others.
e	Foreign applicants shall obtain equivalency certificate from the Association of Indian University.

### 3. BASIS OF SELECTION FOR ADMISSION

- 3.1 A Candidate desirous of seeking admission to First Year Bachelor of Audiology & Speech Language Pathology undergraduate programme should fulfill the minimum eligibility condition as stated in point no. 3 above. The final admission will be offered based solely on the merit obtained at the all India entrance test **ABOP-2025** conducted by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune.
- 3.2 He/ She must have appeared for the **ABOP-2025** entrance Test, conducted by Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), Pune at designated centres.
- 3.3 Mere appearance in the entrance test and inclusion of name in the merit list does not confer any automatic rights to secure admission to the programme offered by the Institute. The selection and admission to the programme is subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria.
- 3.4 In case two or more candidates obtain equal marks in the **ABOP-2025** the inter-se-merit of such candidates shall be determined in order of preference as under:
  - 3.4.1 Candidate obtaining higher marks in aggregate in the qualifying exam, if equal.
  - 3.4.2 Candidate obtaining higher percentage of total marks in the 10th standard examination, if equal
  - 3.4.3 In case of tie at this level, computerized random selection of candidate will be carried out.

### 4. NATURE OF ENTRANCE TEST ABOP-2025

- 4.1 The **ABOP-2025** is a entrance test for admission to **Bachelor of Audiology & Speech Language Pathology** Programme. It will be of 200 marks and shall be of 180 minutes duration.

The entrance test will consists of one question paper, set in English and will contain 200 multiple choice objective-type questions, 60 on Physics, 60 on Chemistry, 80 on Biology (Botany and Zoology) and/or 80 on Mathematics. They will be set on the topics in the syllabus of **11 & 12 std.** It consists of 200 multiple choice questions, one mark each with four alternatives, with only one correct or most appropriate answer. One mark will be awarded for each correct answer. There is no negative marking for entrance test.

Candidate will have to choose either Biology or Mathematics for the entrance test. The entrance test will consist of questions on Physics, Chemistry, either Biology or Mathematics. The choice may be provided during filling up of online application form. Choice of the section once made will not be changed.

**Details regarding general instructions, terms and conditions of the entrance test mode, schedule, entrance test centers, application procedure, Instructions regarding entrance test etc., are available on website. ### 5. ENTRANCE TEST FEE:

- 5.1 **Entrance test fee: Rs 1500/- (Non Refundable)**
- 5.2 The entrance test fee shall be paid through payment gateway using internet banking mode or through debit/credit card/UPI. Service charges and other taxes for transaction as applicable by bank has to be paid by the applicant.
- 5.3 The entrance test fee, once paid, will not be refunded under any circumstances. Candidates who remain absent for the entrance test will forfeit their entrance test fee.



## 6. DECLARATION OF RESULT:

A separate merit list will be declared for candidates registered for Bachelor of Audiology & Speech Language Pathology program based on the entrance test (based on 200 marks), it will be declared & notified at the website. Please visit [www.bvuniversity.edu.in](http://www.bvuniversity.edu.in) for more details.

Separate merit list will be prepared for regular category and Foreign/NRI/PIO/OCI/Institutional Quota Merit Category.

Candidate will have to login at the application portal to view their result. It is not possible to send individual invitation for counselling to the candidates. **It shall be the responsibility of the individual candidate to see their own merit number and appear for the counselling at the designated centre of as per schedule that will be notified at the website.**

## 7. COUNSELLING AND SPOT ADMISSIONS:

The allocation of the institute will be made based on the preference provided by the candidate while filling the online application form. The candidate must note that appearance for the entrance test and inclusion of name in the merit list does not necessarily mean that he/she will get admission to the institute & programme. The admission will depend upon the availability of seats to the particular programme and institute at the time of his counselling.

It shall be candidates responsibility to see the result of the entrance test and confirm their merit no. The candidate should remain present for counselling as per the schedule **notified on the website..**
