#### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE-2024-25**

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:**

The eligibility for admission to 1st year of B.Arch. Degree program for the academic session 2024-2025 shall be as per CoA (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 2020. The eligibility in terms of Regulations, 2020 is as under:

\*No candidate shall be admitted to an architecture course unless he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with at least 50 percent aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics and also at least 50 percent marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as a compulsory subject with at least 50 percent marks in aggregate.

All admissions to architecture degree course shall be subject to passing of National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA-2024) conducted by the council of Architecture or equivalent examination prescribed by Council of Architecture from time to time.

Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) College of Architecture has Separate merit list apart from centralized admission process DTE

#### WEIGHTAGE FOR MERIT LIST

The following shall be the weightage:

Architectural Aptitude (NATA-2024) : 50% (Maximum)

Qualifying Examination : 50% (Maximum)

i.e. 10 + 2 (HSC) or 10 + 3 years

Diploma recognized by Central / State governments OR IB Diploma and / or other test qualifying 50%.

#### **INTAKE CAPACITY:**

#### Total Intake Capacity - 80 seats.

Fifteen (15%) percent of the sanctioned seats are reserved for Foreign/NRI/PIO/OCI/ Institutional Quota Merit category. The candidates seeking admissions to the course through this category need to apply separately on a prescribed application form. The Indian students seeking admission on the seats of this category will have to appear for online NATA-2024 examination (Conducted by council of Architecture) New Delhi. The completed application form should be submitted to the Registrar, Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), L.B.S. Marg, Pune-30. The seats remaining vacant after the allotment of the Foreign/NRI/PIO/OCI Merit students will be allotted to the Indian students under Institutional Quota Merit Category who have applied for admissions on the seats of this category, on the basis of merit determined in terms of marks obtained by them in (12th + NATA-2024) having 50% weightage each.

#### NATIONAL APTITUDE TEST IN ARCHITECTURE (NATA-2024)

(www.nata.in)

This examination is conducted by Council of Architecture, New Delhi. A candidate seeking admission to the B.Arch. course should qualify the NATA-2024. examination.

Application has to be filled up ONLINE at the NATA-2024 portal of NIC http://www.nata.nic.in/www.NATA.IN.

#### Application Procedure for B.Arch.

A candidate desirous of appearing for the Bachelor in Architecture is required to

- a) Complete the prescribed online application form and submit it online on Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) portal after immediate declaration of NATA-2024 results and 12th result.
- b) Submit the printed copy of the online application form along with documents to the College of Architecture, Pune

#### a) Submission of online Application form:

The candidates should strictly follow the instructions given on the website while filling up the application form online and must read the instructions carefully before filling up the online application form.

Before filling up the application form online, candidates should:

- a) Create their login credential.
- b) Have a scanned image of their recent passport size photograph. (Refer to guidelines mentioned on the website)
- c) Have a scanned image of their signature, ready before filling of the online application form.
- d) Have a scanned image of their HSC / equivalent examination marklist

#### Submission of Application.

It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to complete the application form before due date. If the candidate fails to send this information before 7<sup>th</sup> June 2024 for round 1, 4<sup>th</sup> July 2024 for round 2 and 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2024 for round 3, the application will not be considered for admission to the B. Arch. course.

#### **MERIT LIST:**

The University will prepare a merit list of the candidates on the basis of combined weightage of marks obtained by the candidate i.e. 50 % weightage of marks secured in NATA-2024 conducted by Council of Architecture or equivalent examination prescribed by Council of Architecture from time to time. & 50 % weightage of aggregate marks secured in HSC or equivalent examination. The candidates should remain present for the counseling as per their merit number and schedule of counseling.

#### **Declaration of Merit List -**

The University will declare merits list of Regular Merit Category and Foreign/N.R.I./PIO/OCI/ Institutional Quota Merit Category List on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2024 for round 1, 6<sup>th</sup> July 2024 for round 2 and 5<sup>th</sup> August 2024 for round 3. The Merit list will be declared at byuniversity.edu.in candidates have to login to view their result.

In case two or more candidates obtain equal marks after combining both the weightages, as mentioned above, the interse merit of candidates shall be determined in order of preference as under:

Candidates obtaining higher marks in NATA-2024.

Candidates obtaining higher marks in Mathematics subject (HSC / equivalent).

In case of tie at this level, computerized random selection of candidate will be done.

#### **COUNSELING PROCEDURE:**

The counseling sessions will be conducted at Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), College of Architecture, Pune as per the schedule indicated. FAILURE TO REPORT FOR COUNSELING ON THE SCHEDULED DATE AND TIME MAY RESULT IN INSTANTANEOUS CANCELLATION OF CANDIDATE'S CLAIM FOR ADMISSION.

The candidate should remain present for the personal interview (counseling) and for on the spot admission, if eligible, even though he/she does not receive any intimation letter from the University.

Only the candidate and one of the parents/guardian will be allowed into the hall where counseling is held. The candidates will be called in the order of their ranking in the merit list and offered the seats at that point of time.

The candidate must note that appearance at the test and inclusion of names in the Merit list do not necessarily mean that he/she will get admission to the course. His/her admission will depend upon the availability of vacancies at the time of his/her counseling.

A merit list will be displayed on the college website (http://coarcpune.bharatividyapeeth.edu). The responsibility for checking the merit list lies with the candidate and must confirm it with the college.

At the time of reporting for the counseling, the candidate is required to produce the documents (original and two sets of photocopies) listed in Annexure-I. If the candidate is admitted, these documents will be retained by the University till he/she completes the course. If the candidate fails to produce all or any of the documents listed in Annexure, he/she will instantaneously forfeit his/her claim for a seat.

If any candidate finds it impossible to be physically present for the counseling due to unavoidable circumstances, he/she may authorize any other responsible individual to represent him/her at the counseling. This representative must carry with him/her the letter of authorization in the format given in **Annexure-II** as well as all the documents listed in **Annexure-I**. If the candidate or his/her representative fails to report for the counseling on the date & time mentioned in the schedule of counseling, his /her claim for admission to the course will be forfeited.

College will not be responsible to send invitations for counseling to the candidates individually. They may attend the counseling sessions as per the schedule of counseling on their own, it is the responsibility of the candidate to check their name on the merit list that will be displayed on the institution's "Website" http://coarcpune.bharatividyapeeth.edu. in case of difficulty student may call the college office for confirmation at 020-24375687.

If a candidate fails to confirm admission given to him/her, the same shall stand cancelled and the resultant vacancy will be offered to the next eligible candidate from the Entrance Test Merit list. There are a few seats available in the hostel which will be allotted on first come first served basis.
