It is hereby notified for the information of all concerned that the Academic Council at its 71st meeting held on 08-10-2024 has resolved to adopt and approve the revised syllabus of the course 'Environmental Studies' to be implemented from the Academic Year 2024-25.

- The course can be made part of the curriculum for most of the UG programmes except the programmes under Health Sciences and for those whose curriculum is as per Council requirements.
- The inclusion of the course as a part of the curriculum shall be implemented from the academic year 2024-25. Wherever the course is already a part of the curriculum, the revised syllabus needs to be adopted.
- The course shall be implemented either through
 - A) By splitting the 9 units in two Modules over any two semesters i.e.
 - (i) **Environmental Studies - I** (One Semester) – of 3 credits (consisting of the first eight units and conducting the teaching learning for 46 hours).
 - (ii) **Environmental Studies - II** (another Semester) – of 1 credit (consisting of the 9th Unit – "Case studies and field work " for 30 hours.

OR

- B) By conducting all the 9 units as one module in **any one semester/term** for 46+30 hours. 4 credits shall be awarded upon successful completion.

Each faculty/discipline/program shall have a choice of any one either (A) OR (B). The choice made will not be changed. The choice has to be communicated to University and Controller of Examinations.

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The Evaluation shall be conducted for 100 marks (University examinations – UE – 60 marks and Internal Assessment – IA – 40 marks), which is as follows:

- The teaching learning shall be conducted –
 - (i) Either fully by the current faculty/visiting faculty.
 - (ii) Through Hybrid Mode i.e. by a faculty and by developing appropriate content and disseminating through Online Mode.
- The Faculty Members of the Institute of Environment Education and Research shall be responsible to develop such content required for teaching learning through both Formal Mode & Hybrid Mode.
- They shall also prepare case studies that relate to each domain of the programme in consultation with the concerned Principal/Director. They shall ensure that Faculty of other institutes are trained through regular FDPs.
- Wherever possible, joint sessions can be conducted for students of institutes located at the same campus.
- For the UG programmes under Health Sciences, the revised syllabus shall be implemented, however their results shall be declared as per existing system of declaring results i.e. either PASS or FAIL.
- The responsibility of incorporating this subject in the curriculum & teaching is the responsibility of the respective Principal/Director.
