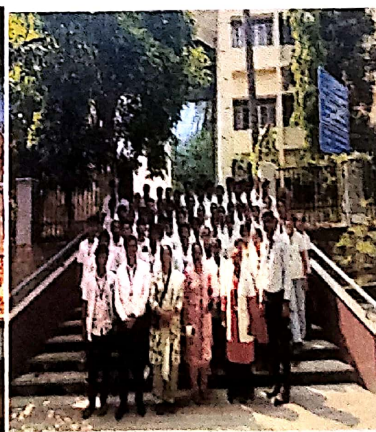
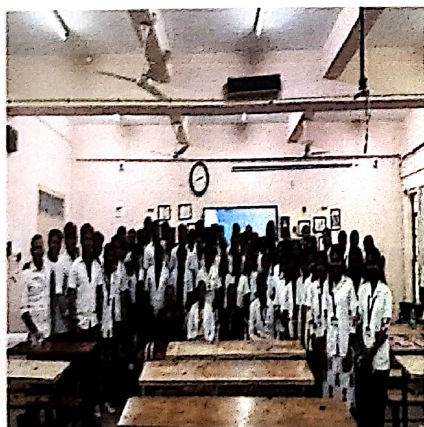
Report of the Educational Visit.

The Hospital is of 1096 beds.



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
