#### **Day 1: Traditional day .**

The college week took place from 16<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup> Dec 2024 and 19<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup> Dec 2024. Each day of the college week had a specific theme, and students were required to dress accordingly. The first day was Traditional day, where students had to wear traditional attire. The Master of Ceremonies for the day were Ms. Ashli Mariam Anil and Ms. Binta Kurein. The program was officially inaugurated by the esteemed Principal Dr. Mrs. Bhagyashree Jogdeo, along with Vice Principal Dr. Suresh Ray, SNA advisors Dr. Mrs. Sushila Devi and Mrs. Sunita Chavan, cultural committee incharges Mrs. Rucha Bade and Mrs. Priti Rajput and all SNA executives were also part of it who lit the lamp.
