b) Minimum Qualification

- This is a Two year full time course. Any student after passing graduation examination or equivalent examination from a recognized University can apply for the Program.
- The candidate has to undergo an audition test before a panel of eminent scholars from the field of Music.
- This program is not for beginners. Candidates should have good knowledge of the field in which he / she is applying.

c) Minimum Mandatory Experience while applying

Music

- Vocal: Candidate should know Seven Ragas. Candidate should be able sing Khayal (Wilambit and Drut) or Dhrupad with its proper elaboration in any one Raga by playing his / her own Tanpura for 15 mins.
- Instrumental (Non Percussion): (Harmonium, Flute, Santoor, Sarod, Shehnai, Sundri, Sarangi, Sitar and Violin.) Nine streams are available for this course. Candidate should know Seven Ragas and should be able to play Masitkhani and Razakhani Gat or Bandish (Wilambit and Drut) in any one Raga for 15 Min.
- Instrumental (Percussion): Candidate should know five Taals, components of solo playing and accompaniment. Candidate should be able to play one Taal including Peshkar / Prastar, Kayada, Paran, Rela Tukda, chakradhar etc for 15 mins.
