At present there are only three Dental College in Mumbai Divisional area and it is desirable to grant permission to start a new Dental College by Bharti Vidyapeeth, PUNE's Dental College at C.B.D. Navi Mumbai in the said divisional area.

This certificate is being given on the condition that the College will fulfil the norms and conditions laid down by the Dental Council of India, New Delhi and the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and will not employ/engage any teacher from the Government Dental College except their retirement and superannuation.
