REPORT ON WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY RALLY AND PLEDGE

In observance of **World No Tobacco Day 2025**, Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), College of Nursing, Sangli organized an awareness rally and a pledge ceremony on 31st May 2025. The theme for this year's World No Tobacco Day, as declared by the World Health Organization (WHO), was "**Protecting children from tobacco industry interference.**"

Objective:

1. Rally:
