She provided insight into legal and ethical implications and explained the official process to report such misleading information as per the AYUSH guidelines.

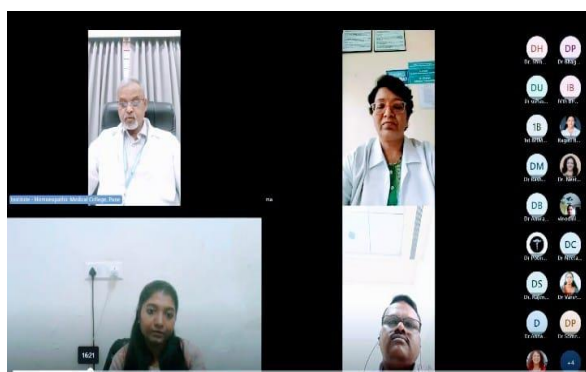
