Admission Process

Eligibility Criteria

Undergraduate Program

Candidates who have cleared the HSC (10+2) or equivalent exam with a minimum passing grade from any stream (Science, Arts, Commerce, Fine Arts etc.) will be considered eligible for admission.

Candidates must register for the Common Entrance Test (CET), which includes a Personal Interview and Portfolio Assessment. No written exam.

Provisional admission will only be confirmed after clearing CET-2026.
