- 1. Maximum 250 words (English)
- 2. Font styles: Times New Roman, size 12, single spacing
- 3. Include Introduction, Methods, Results, and Conclusion.
- 4. Time duration: not more than 5 minutes with 8 to 10 slides
- 5. All papers will be assessed by the Scientific committee

#### SCIENTIFIC POSTER PRESENTATION

- 1. The title of the poster should be the same as that of your abstract.
- 2. The size of the poster should be 18" x 24" (46 cm x 61 cm) in portrait view.
- 3. Overall design should be clean, professional & readable from various distances.

#### GUIDELINES FOR PAPER / POSTER PRESENTATION

- 1. Only one person will take part in either paper or poster presentations.
- 2. The last date of registration is on or before 20/11/2025.
- 3. Abstracts of both the paper and poster presentation need to be submitted through e-mail on or before 20/11/2025.

The best 3 papers and posters will be awarded on the same day as the conference.
