3. Workshop on Documentation and Record Keeping by Dr. Rahul Shetty

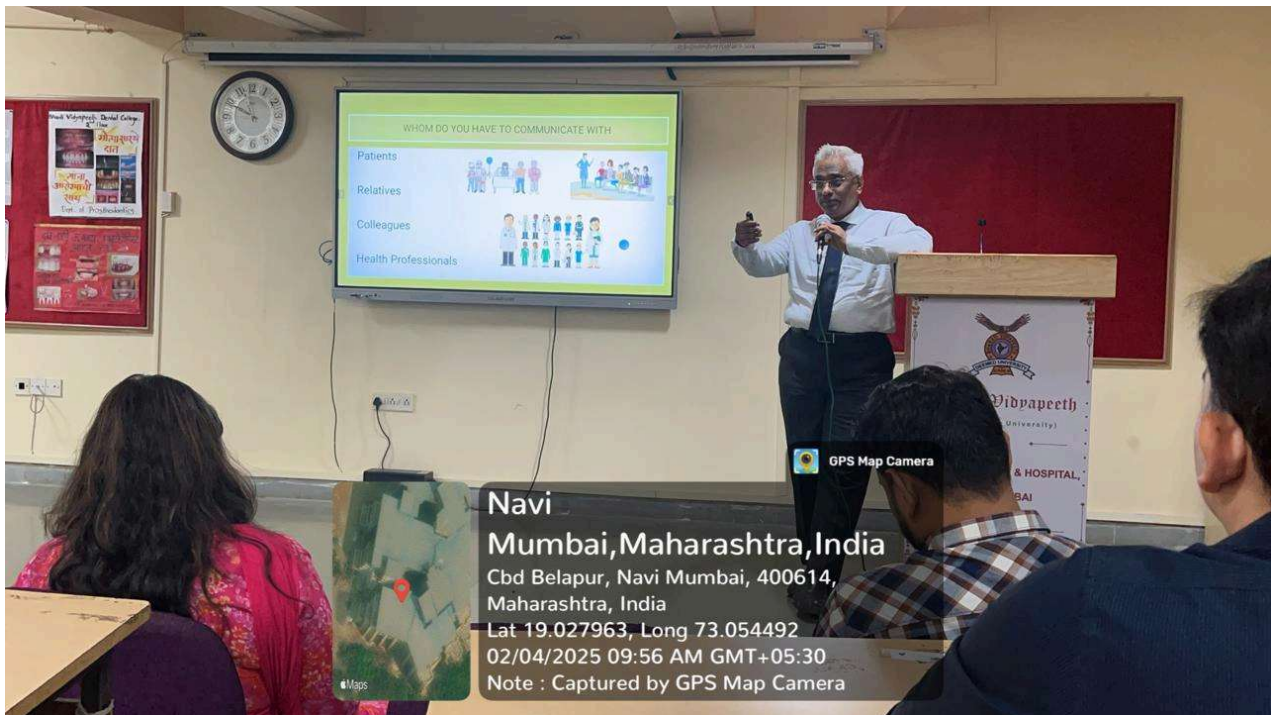

- Closing Remarks. Orientation was concluded with Vote of Thanks by Dr. Sneha Mhasne (Master of Ceremony)

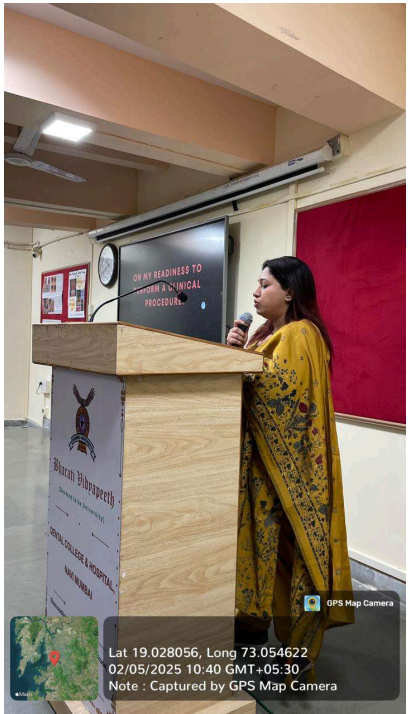
Conclusion
