The event witnessed active participation from 24 beneficiaries, who engaged with the content and asked insightful questions. The skit served as a powerful medium to convey complex medical information in a relatable and memorable way. The program concluded with an interactive discussion, reinforcing the significance of physiotherapy in post-stroke care and encouraging attendees to seek timely help.

Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University), School of Physiotherapy, Sangli, successfully organized a free Pediatric Physiotherapy Camp at Vadaketh Vikas Kendra, Miraj. The camp, held from 11 am to 4 pm, focused on the theme "Screening and Treatment for Children with Special Needs." As part of an IQAC initiative, the event aimed to provide early intervention and therapeutic support to children requiring specialized physiotherapy care. 20 BPT and 4 staff assessed the children and prescribed individualized treatment plans tailored to each child's needs. The initiative received an enthusiastic response benefiting 22 children.

The camp was coordinated by Neuro Physiotherapy Department, Dr. Manal Anthikat (HOD and Professor, BVDU SOP, Sangli), Dr. Aishwarya Bulbule (Assisstant Professor, BVDU SOP, Sangli), Dr. Prachi Bhanushali (Assisstant Professor, BVDU SOP, Sangli) and Dr Kevin Makasare (Clinical Therapist, Bharati Hospital, Sangli). - 1. Enhanced Clinical Exposure
 - Students gained hands-on experience in assessing and treating children with special needs, improving their clinical reasoning and therapeutic skills in a real-world setting.
- 2. Improved Communication Skills
 - Interacting with children, parents, and healthcare professionals helped students develop empathy and refine their ability to explain medical concepts in simple, relatable terms.
- 3. Teamwork and Collaboration
 - Working alongside faculty and peers fostered a spirit of collaboration, teaching students the importance of coordinated care in multidisciplinary settings.
- 4. Community Engagement and Awareness
 - Participating in an outreach initiative instilled a sense of social responsibility and highlighted the role of physiotherapists in promoting inclusive healthcare at the grassroots level.










4. How would rate the success of the event


5. How would you rate content and quality of event




7. How would you rate the preparations of the speakers
