


Educational Tour to Lucknow under My Bharat Scheme

















An educational tour to Lucknow was successfully organized from 22nd to 25th December 2025 under the My Bharat Scheme with the objective of broadening students' understanding of history, culture, civic sense, industry, and social awareness. The My Bharat initiative aims to connect youth with nation-building activities by promoting civic engagement, social

responsibility, and community service. It provides a platform for young citizens to contribute meaningfully to India's development while gaining practical learning experiences.

Tour Overview

The tour was scheduled from 20th December to 25th December 2025, with participants arriving in Lucknow on the night of 21st December 2025. A total of 35 students from five different districts participated in this educational initiative.

Orientation Programme

Lectures and Awareness Sessions (23rd December 2025)

Students attended a series of informative sessions:

- A lecture on traffic rules and road safety, promoting responsible civic behaviour
- An industrial session by the Adani Cement Branch Manager, explaining cement manufacturing processes, quality standards, and applications
- A lecture by Mr. Yogesh Tripathi on politics and civic awareness, enhancing understanding of governance and democratic systems

Spiritual Visit and Cultural Programme (24th December 2025)
