**Eligibility for Admission, Programme Structure, Course Components,
Curriculum, Examination Pattern and Standard of Passing**

**B.B.A., LL.B. (Bachelor of Business Administration and Bachelor of
Laws)**

B.B.A., LL.B. (Bachelor of Business Administration and Bachelor of Laws)

- 1) It shall be a Five (5) Year Integrated Under-graduate Degree Programme in Business Administration and Law. The program shall be divided into ten (10) Semesters.
- 2) In line with the UGC guidelines, the courses are categorized as Major Core Courses, Ability Enhancement Courses (Practical Training Papers), Skill Enhancement Courses, Discipline Specific Elective Courses and Interdisciplinary Courses.
- 3) **Prohibition to register for two Regular Programs of Study:** No student shall be allowed to simultaneously register for a law degree programme with any other Graduate or Post-Graduate programme run by the same or any other University or an Institute for academic or professional learning.
- 4) The medium of instruction and examination shall be **English**.
- 5) The rules given herein are for the general understanding of the candidates. However, the admission to First Year of BB.A., LL.B., shall be subject to the rules made and conditions prescribed, from time to time, by the University, Central Government, State Government, Bar Council of India, University Grants Commission or any other authority empowered.

ELIGIBILITY

An applicant who has successfully completed Senior Secondary School Course ('+2') or equivalent (such as 11+1, 'A' level in Senior School Leaving Certificate Course) from a recognized University of India or outside or from a Senior Secondary Board or equivalent, constituted or recognized by the Union or by a State Government or from any equivalent institution from a foreign country recognized by the government of that country for the purpose of issue of qualifying certificate on successful completion of the course, may apply for and be admitted into the programme of the Centres of Legal Education to obtain the integrated degree in law with a degree in any other subject as the first degree from the University whose such a degree in law is recognized by the Bar Council of India for the purpose of enrolment.

Provided that applicants who have obtained + 2 Higher Secondary Pass Certificate or First Degree Certificate after prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered as eligible for admission in the Integrated Five Years course.

Explanation: The applicants who have obtained 10 + 2 through open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission in the law courses.

NATURE OF EXAMINATION

- No student shall be allowed to take the end semester test in a subject if the student concerned has not attended minimum of 70% of the classes held in the subject concerned as also the moot court room exercises, tutorials and practical training conducted in the subject taken together.(as per BCI Rules)
- Each paper shall be of 100 Marks out of which 40 Marks shall be for Internal Assessment (IA) and 60 Marks shall be for University Examination (UE).
- For all courses there shall be Internal Assessment (IA) conducted by the respective institution and end-of-the-term University Examination (UE) conducted by the University. The UE will be based on the entire syllabus.

Guidelines as to distribution of 40 marks for each course, except for Practical Training Courses, for Internal Assessment shall be as under:

- The selection of internal assessment component and the guidelines for distribution of marks for Internal Assessment shall be at the discretion of the Principal / Director/HoD.
- There shall not be Written Examination conducted by the University for two Papers namely:
 1. Practical Training Paper II - Drafting, Pleading and Conveyance
 2. Practical Training Paper III - Moot Court Exercise & Internship (Clinical Course)

Practical Training Paper II - Drafting, Pleading and Conveyance

Written Journal Submission on Drafting (30 Marks), Pleading (30 Marks) and Conveyance (30 Marks) and Viva Voce examination 10 Marks.

Practical Training Paper III – Moot Court Exercise & Internship (Clinical Course)

Moot Court (30 Marks), Observance of Trials (30 Marks) and Interviewing Technique and Pre-Trial Preparations (30 Marks) and Viva Voce Examination (10 Marks).

THE CREDIT SYSTEM

The credits specified for BB.A. LL.B. 5 years programme describe the weightage of various courses of the programme. The number of credits along with grade points that the student has satisfactorily completed measures the performance of the student. Satisfactory progress of a student is subject to his/ her maintaining a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA), as well as minimum grades in different courses of the programme. A certain number of credits must be earned by the student to qualify for the degree. Description of credit distribution for Major Core Courses, Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (Practical Training Papers), Skill Enhancement Courses, Discipline Specific Elective Courses and Interdisciplinary Courses has already been shown.

There shall be a 10-Point Absolute Grading System for grading in each head of passing. The performance indicators O, A+, A, B+, B, and F shall respectively mean:

EVALUATION AND COMPUTATION OF THE GRADE POINT AVERAGES

Cumulative performance indicators such as GPA, SGPA or CGPA shall be calculated as described and illustrated below.

- A. The performances at UE and IA will be combined to obtain the Grade Point Average (GPA) for the Course/ Paper.
- B. The weightage for performance at UE and IA shall respectively be 60% and 40%.
- C. The Grade Point Average (GPA) for a Course/ Paper shall be calculated by first finding the total marks out of 100 for the Course/ Paper.
- D. Two kinds of performance indicators, namely, the Semester Grade point Average (SGPA) and the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) shall be computed at the end of each term. The SGPA measures the cumulative performance of a learner in all the Courses/ Paper in a particular Semester, while CGPA measures the cumulative performance in all courses/ papers since his/her enrollment. The CGPA of a learner when he/she completes the programme is the Final Result of the learner.

STANDARDS OF PASSING

- A. In order to pass in a Semester, a Student must obtain a minimum grade point of 6.00 (50%) both at the UE and IA.
- B. A Student who passes in a Course/ Paper is said to have completed the Credits assigned to the Course/ Paper.
- C. A Student who completed the minimum Credits required for a programme will be declared to have completed the programme.
- D. Minimum passing grade shall be Grade 'B' for each course/ Paper.

RULES OF PROMOTION AND DURATION TO COMPLETE ENTIRE COURSE

- The Students can be permitted to take admission to the subsequent year/semester irrespective of the number of subjects passed.

SINGLE INTEGRATED DEGREE

As per the UGC rules, a Candidate admitted in BB.A. LL.B 5 Years Programme is entitled for Single Degree only (BB.A. LL.B) that too after the successful completion of 5 years programme. They shall not be entitled for Dual Degree as the duration of the Programme is only five years.

AWARD OF DEGREE

A Student who has completed the minimum credits specified for the programme shall be declared to have passed in the programme. The Final result will be in terms of letter grade only and is based on the CGPA of all Courses studied and passed. The Criteria for the award of degree is given below.
