



Report on Geriatric Day Celebration

Details of the Activity:

The Department of Prosthodontics organized a **Geriatric Day Celebration** aimed at providing complete denture prostheses to the underprivileged elderly population. The event began with a lamp-lighting ceremony led by geriatric patients, Dr. Raghavendra Adaki, Professor and Head, Department of Prosthodontics, and faculty in charge from various departments.

Dr. Raghavendra Adaki addressed the gathering, emphasizing the importance of comprehensive oral health care for the geriatric population and its role in enhancing their overall quality of life. Complete denture prostheses were distributed to all the beneficiaries, fabricated and delivered by final-year BDS students of the Department of Prosthodontics under the guidance of faculty members.

The geriatric patients who visited the department on this occasion were educated through audio-visual aids and demonstration models about the various prosthodontic treatment modalities available.

They were also counseled on maintaining oral hygiene and the importance of proper nutrition, thereby promoting better oral and general health awareness among the elderly by the postgraduate students. Keeping the view of the geriatric day, free dental screening camp was organized on 24th September for elderly patients at Vruddha Sevashram, Sangli, which included oral examination, prosthodontic evaluation, and education on oral hygiene maintenance. Postgraduate students actively participated in assisting and interacting with the geriatric patients under faculty guidance.

ICPA company sponsored **denture cleansing tablets** and **Mucopain ointment** for the event. These products were **freely distributed to the geriatric patients** by the **postgraduate students** of the Department of Prosthodontics.

Objectives of the activity are-

- 1) To provide complete denture prostheses to the underprivileged elderly population.
- 2) To create awareness about oral health care needs of the geriatric population.
- 3) To sensitize students towards the challenges faced by elderly patients in maintaining oral health and prosthetic rehabilitation.
- 4) To promote empathy, communication, and holistic care for senior citizens.
