An Anti-Ragging Orientation Programme was conducted at the institution to create awareness among students about the seriousness of ragging and the importance of maintaining a safe and respectful academic environment. The lecture was delivered by Dr. Arun Dodamani, Hon'ble Member of the Dental Council of India (DCI), who is widely recognized for his contributions to dental education and student welfare. The session was attended by 1st year undergraduate and Post Graduate students, along with faculty members.

The session started with Introduction of Guest Speaker Dr. Arun Doadamani sir by 1st Year BDS co ordinators Dr Shweta Gangawane and Dr. Sujeet Patil. Felicitation of Dr. Arun Doadamani sir was done by Dr Raghavendra Adaki sir, Followed by felicitation of Dr Raghavendra Adaki sir by Dr Chetan Patil sir and Dr Anirudha Shete sir.

Dr. Arun Dodamani began the lecture by explaining the concept of ragging and its various forms. He emphasized that ragging is not limited to physical abuse but also includes verbal harassment, psychological intimidation, bullying, and any behaviour that causes humiliation or mental distress to students. He clearly stated that such actions, even if perceived as harmless fun, can have serious consequences on a student's mental health and academic performance.

The speaker elaborated on the legal aspects of ragging, highlighting that ragging is a punishable offence under Indian law. He explained the strict guidelines issued by regulatory bodies such as the Dental Council of India and other authorities, which enforce a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging. Dr. Dodamani sir informed the students about the penalties imposed on those found guilty, including suspension, expulsion, and legal action, and stressed that institutions are also held accountable for ensuring a ragging-free campus.

Dr. Dodamani sir further discussed the responsibilities of students, faculty, and college authorities in preventing ragging. He urged senior students to act as mentors and support systems for juniors rather than engaging in intimidating behaviour. He also encouraged junior students to speak up and report any incidents without fear, assuring them that confidentiality and protection are provided through institutional anti-ragging mechanisms.

The lecture also focused on the psychological and emotional impact of ragging, explaining how it can lead to anxiety, depression, loss of confidence, and in extreme cases, severe emotional trauma. Through real-life examples, Dr. Dodamani sir conveyed the long-term damage ragging can cause and emphasized the importance of empathy, mutual respect, and healthy interaction among students.



In conclusion, Dr. Arun Dodamani sir strongly emphasized that ragging has no place in educational institutions and that every student has the right to learn in a safe and fear-free environment. The lecture successfully reinforced the message of zero tolerance towards ragging and encouraged students to contribute positively to building a respectful and inclusive campus culture. The programme was concluded by delivering certificate of appreciation to Dr. Arun Dodamani sir by Dr Raghavendra Adaki sir and felicitation of Girls Hostel Warden, Jagtap Madam and Nilam Chavan Madam. Vote of Thanks was delivered by Dr Shweta Gangawane (1st year Co-ordinator).
