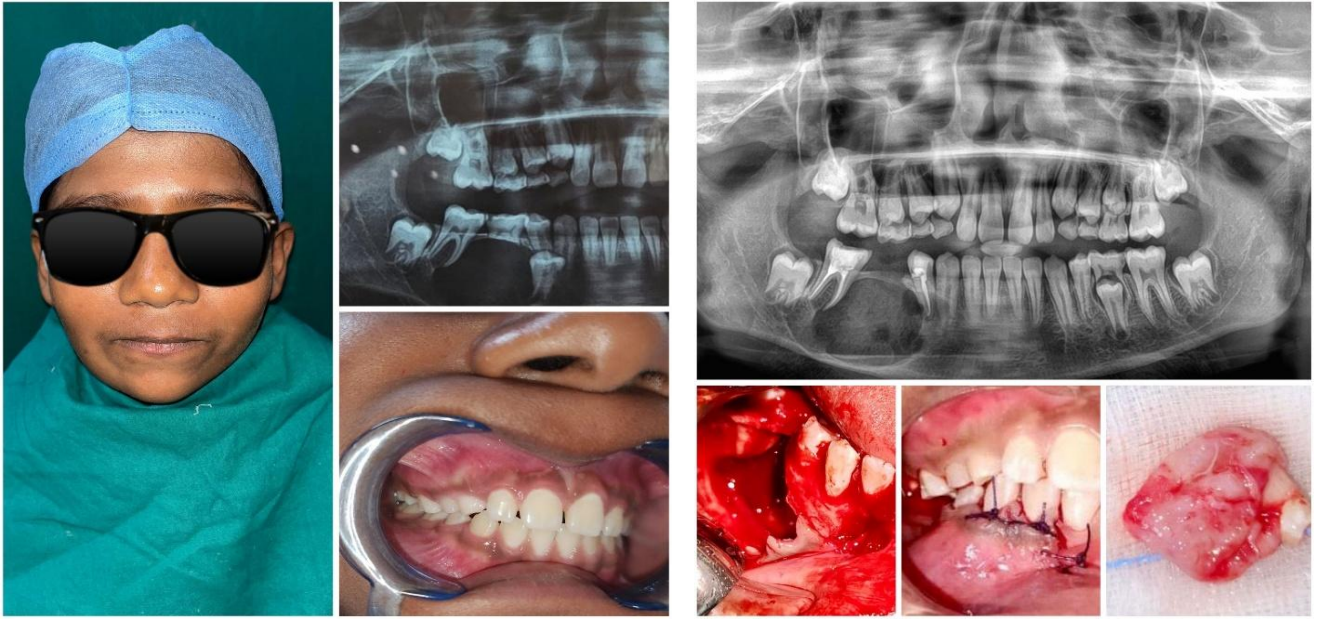

The interdepartmental case was presented by Dr.Janhavi Kanetkar, Post Graduate Student Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry and Dr.Nidhhi Bihani, Post graduate student, Department of Oral and maxillofacial Surgery. Topic of presentation was ***“Unicystic Ameloblastoma- Case Report”***. Following root canal treatment of involved molars by department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry, cystic enucleation and curettage was performed by department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery under general anesthesia. Histological diagnosis confirmed as Unicystic Ameloblastoma. Further recall visits for healing of lesion and implant placement with prosthesis are planned.





The presentation was attended by Head of Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry and Head of Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, all teaching faculty members (10), and students (45). An active discussion regarding the case and different possibilities that could be encountered during the case took place post the presentation between the PG students and teaching faculty members.
