The “**National Periodontist Day**” was celebrated in Department of Periodontology on 23/02/2026 from 10 AM – 1:00 PM at Bharthi Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) Dental college and Hospital, Sangli. The Periodontist Day was inaugurated by, all the Head of Departments. National Periodontist Day is celebrated all across India on 23rd February, 2026 to commemorate the foundation day of Indian Society of Periodontology.



Various events are conducted all over India to create an awareness among general public about the importance of maintaining oral hygiene and different ways and measures to prevent various dental and systemic diseases.

As a part of this program, Dr. Chinmayi introduced the guest and it was followed by lamp lightening. On the occasion of National Periodontist Day, the Department of Periodontology organized a Quiz Competition and Dumb Charades event on 20th February 2026 in Lecture Hall 03. The primary objective of the program was to enhance students' knowledge of periodontology, encourage active learning, promote teamwork, and create awareness about the importance of periodontal health. The quiz competition included multiple rounds covering fundamental and clinical aspects of periodontology, while the dumb charades activity involved identifying periodontal terms and instruments in an engaging manner. The events witnessed enthusiastic participation from undergraduate students. The winners of both competitions were felicitated and awarded in recognition of their excellent performance.



As part of the National Periodontist Day initiative, the department provided **free dental scaling services** to promote the importance of professional oral cleaning. This initiative helped raise awareness among patients about the need for routine dental check-ups and maintenance of oral hygiene.

To further encourage periodontal health care, a **50% concession on periodontal surgical procedures** was offered to patients. This initiative aimed to make advanced dental care more accessible and affordable. Patients visiting the clinic during the celebration week were provided with **free oral hygiene aid samples**, including toothbrushes, toothpaste, interdental brushes, and mouthwash. This was done to educate and motivate patients to adopt effective daily oral hygiene practices.
