The Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery organized a programme on the occasion of World Disability Day on 3rd December 2025 in Lecture Hall-1. The event aimed to promote awareness, inclusivity, and sensitivity towards individuals with disabilities, especially within the dental healthcare.

A total of 35 students attended the programme. 12 in-charges and Heads of Departments, were present, reflecting strong academic and administrative support for the initiative.

The session commenced with a brief introduction on the significance of observing World Disability Day, followed by a special talk delivered by Dr. Nupur Chawala, 2nd-year Postgraduate student, who addressed the importance of disability awareness in dentistry. Her talk emphasized the need for empathetic communication, accessible clinical environments, and modifications in dental practice to cater to patients with physical, sensory, and intellectual disabilities.

This programme was helpful for all the students and faculty members for Understanding and respecting the diverse needs of individuals with disabilities. The importance of barrier-free dental clinics (ramps, wider doorways, wheelchair-accessible dental chairs). Behavior guidance techniques and communication strategies for patients with sensory or cognitive challenges.
