The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) of Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) Dental College and Hospital organised a lecture on “**Ending Gender Based Violence**” on 9th December 2025 at 2:30 pm in Auditorium. It was attended by 100 students which included Interns, 2nd year and 3rd year BDS students.

This lecture was conducted as a part of 16 days of Annual activism for ending gender based violence initiative by UGC which was observed from 25th Nov to 10th Dec 2025. The speaker for this lecture was Dr Pallavi Kamble, Associate Professor, Dept of Periodontics and member of ICC.

The speaker addressed various aspects of gender based violence that can occur in healthcare settings. She discussed measures that can create a secure and supportive campus and hospital environment, free from fear, discrimination and abuse. Emphasis was laid on ending gender based violence for improving overall quality of healthcare facility and reinforcing our commitment to compassion, equality and human dignity.

The speaker shared information on various helpline platforms which provide support to women in distress like SHe-Box [Sexual Harassment Electronic Box Portal], Emergency response number [112] and Women's Helpline [181]. Participants were also enlightened on Mission Shakti Umbrella programme launched by Central government aimed at safety, security and empowerment of women across India.
