The lecture was conducted on zoom meeting in auditorium and was attended by 77 students and 38 teachers. Introduction of Guest speaker was done by Miss Vishakha Taware Intern posted in the Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics.



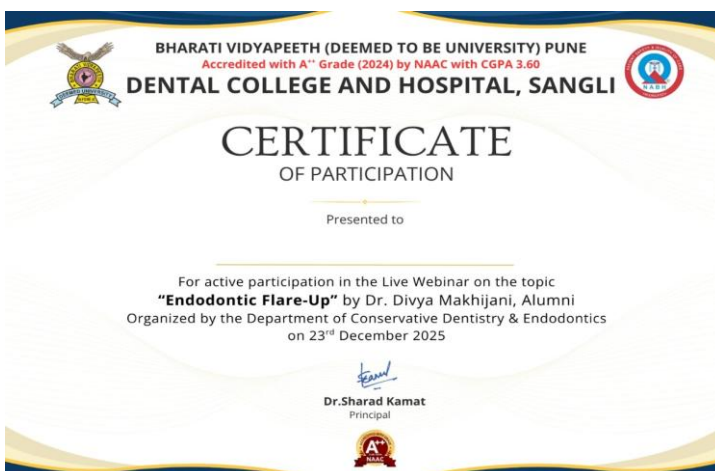
The webinar started by introduction to Endodontic flare-ups. The speaker stated that an endodontic flare-up is an acute exacerbation of pain and/or swelling occurring during or after root canal treatment that requires an unscheduled visit. Most flare-ups are self-limiting, but they significantly affect patient confidence and comfort. Dental graduates can perform accurate working length determination and apical patency without over-instrumentation. They understood the importance of adequate irrigation with controlled pressure,

Use of crown-down techniques, proper case selection and effective temporary restorations. The webinar provided insights into meticulous technique, sound diagnosis, and effective patient communication.

The session ended with vote of thanks presented by Miss Vishakha Taware. The esteemed speaker was presented with e-certificate of appreciation. Online Feedback forms were distributed to the attendees after the session. The feedback analysis report was generated.
