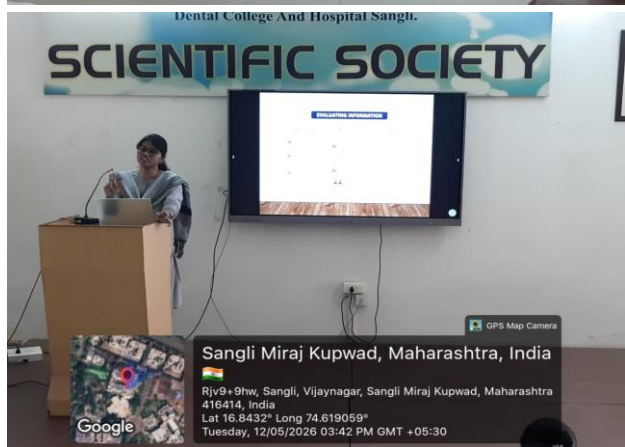

The Central Research and Publication Unit (CRPU) of Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) Dental College and Hospital organized a two-day scientific activity titled **“ICMR-STs Research Orientation and Proposal Writing”** on 12th and 13th May 2026 for undergraduate students and faculty members.

The activity was conducted with the objective of orienting students towards scientific research, enhancing their understanding of research methodology, and guiding them in the preparation and submission of ICMR-STS research proposals. The programme commenced on 12th May 2026 with the inaugural session on **“Introduction to Research; Concepts and Importance”** delivered by Dr. Priya Patil, Professor, Department of Anatomy, BV(DU)MCH, Sangli. The session highlighted the importance of research in healthcare education and emphasised the role of scientific inquiry in evidence-based practice. This was followed by an informative lecture on **“Literature Search; Finding the Right Evidence”** by Dr. Priyanka Paul, Madhu, Assistant Professor, Department of Public Health Dentistry, BV(DU)DCH, Sangli, wherein students were introduced to effective literature search strategies, database utilization, and identification of authentic scientific evidence.



On 13th May 2026, the scientific sessions continued with a lecture on **“Research Design; Blueprint of Research”** by Dr. Pratik Phansopkar, Professor and HOD, Department of Musculoskeletal Physiotherapy, BV(DU) School of Physiotherapy, Sangli. The session focused on various research designs, framing of research objectives, methodology planning, and ethical considerations in research.



The final and most interactive session on **“Proposal Writing for ICMR-STS and Steps for Submission – Hands-on”** was conducted by Dr. Shaheen Shaikh., Professor, Department of Biochemistry, BV(DU)MCH, Sangli. The session provided practical guidance regarding proposal preparation, formatting, submission procedures, and important aspects to be considered while applying for the ICMR-STS programme.



The programme concluded successfully with positive feedback from the participants. The Central Research and Publication Unit (CRPU) expressed gratitude to all the resource persons, faculty members, and students for their active participation and contribution towards the successful conduct of the activity.

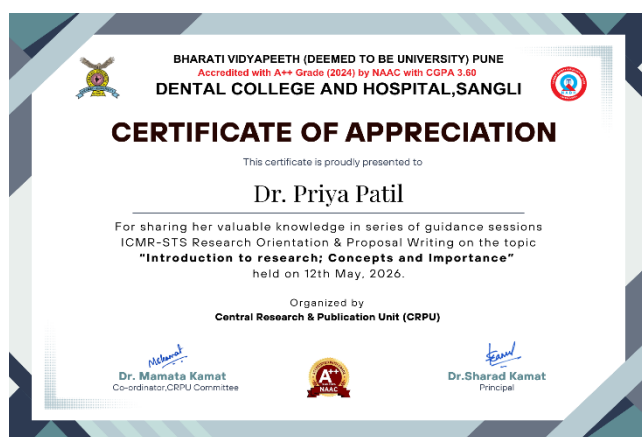
