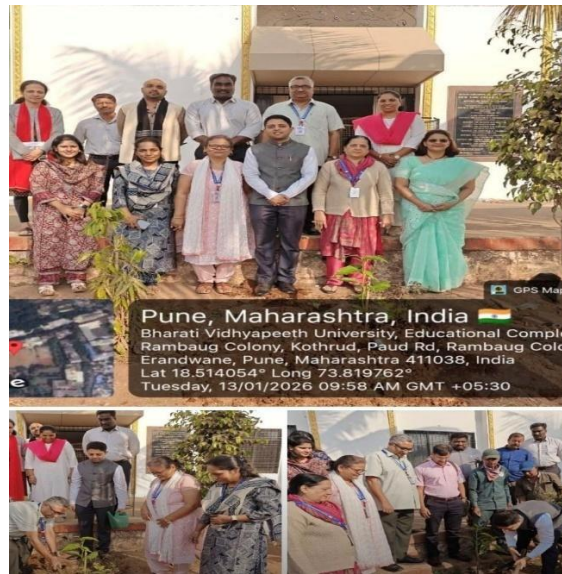

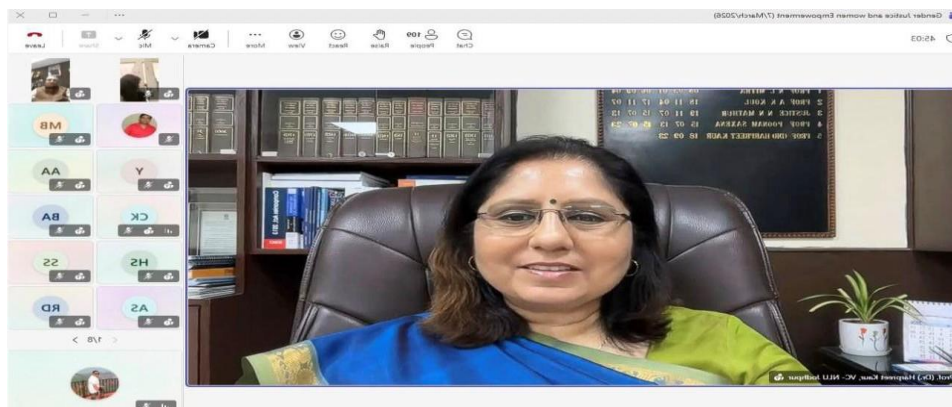

The event featured a distinguished panel of speakers from diverse professional backgrounds follow as-

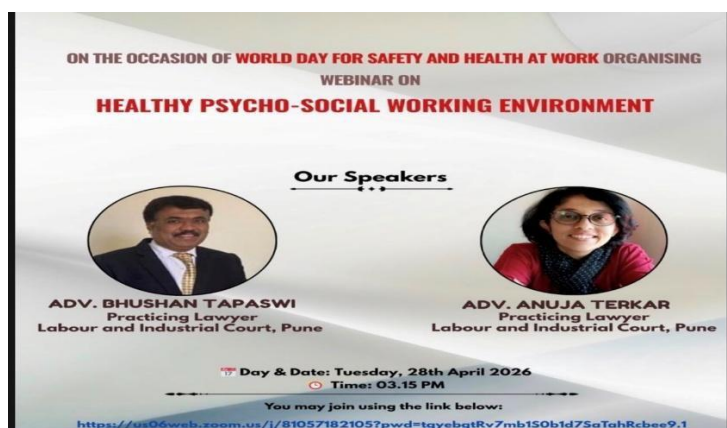
