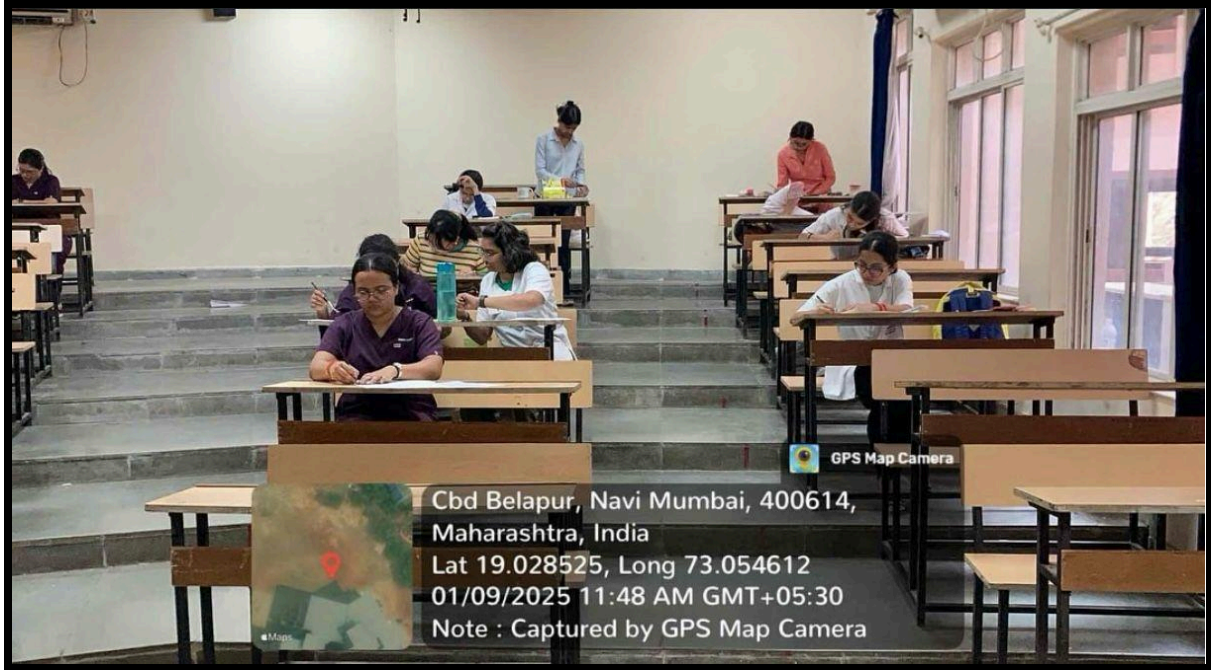
1. To make the event more inclusive, consider inviting students from other institutions and colleges.
