SPECIAL WINTER CAMP 19-25 DECEMBER 2025

The NSS Unit of BVDU-HMC, Pune organized a seven-day Special Winter Camp during the academic year (2025-26) in between 19.12.25 to 25.12.2025 with permission from Prof. Dr. Anita Patil and University NSS Coordinator Prof. Dr. Avinash R. Mhetre. A total of 50 volunteers (16 boys and 34 girls) participated. The camp focused on community health services, health awareness, field work, social responsibility and student development.

Major Activities: The camp began with an inauguration and motivational address by Sarpanch Mr. Vilas Halande. Health activities included haemoglobin and random blood sugar testing, general health check-ups, free treatment and distribution of Homoeopathic medicines at Rulegaon and surrounding villages. At Rulegaon, 71 females received Hb, BSL (R) and health check-up services; around 69 students were screened at the ZP Primary School and 51 students and faculty were examined at Shree Kalbhairavnath Vidyalaya and Matoshri Sonabai Ramchandra Dedage Vidyalaya. Volunteers also visited an old age home, conducted cleaning and painting activities, and promoted personal hygiene, balanced diet, yoga and exercise. Awareness programmes covered cyber security, Shivcharitra, voting rights and prevention of child marriage. SSC students received educational counselling. Guest lectures enriched volunteers' learning in Naturopathy & Homoeopathy, Cyber Security and Shivcharitra.
