- In the key note address- Prof.Dr. T. V. Kattimani discover the glance of;
 - I. Tribal Identity as depicted in Oral Literature: Tribal oral literature, transmitted over centuries and sometimes millenniums, consists of stories, songs, riddles and other genres, which reflect the tribal worldview, lifestyle and wisdom. They also illustrate knowledge traditions about the environment,

as tribals have been the custodians of elements of nature such as forests, minerals, domestic and wild animals.

- II. **Tribal Epics and Indian Knowledge Systems**: Tribal epics, composed in different tribal languages, are storehouses of tribal art as well as knowledge systems such as that of cultivation techniques, water management, flora and fauna, and health traditions.
- III. Future Development of Tribal Through Education Policy and System: He stressed on mother tongue education for tribals and steps should be taken to upgrade their knowledge system with proper utilisation of technology and opening up of innovation training centres.
- IV. Apart from this, spoken English and Hindi skills of the tribals should be developed so that they can express themselves. The tribals have to be ambassadors of their ownership, he added.

After the key note address Question Answer Session has conducted ,were various Academic Fertility in BVDU-Sub campus discuss Tribal Community, Knowledge system, future strategies in upcoming Education system etc.
