
Objectives of the conference –

He also discussed about what are the lifestyle intervention and behavioural approaches needed for care of diabetic person, what self-management can be done by the individual the session was ended at 2:00 pm.



Lunch break was given at 2:00 pm and after the delicious lunch at 3:00 pm third session of the programme was started. Ms. Nikita Bhandari invited the third speaker of the day **Dr. Raghunath B. Kulkarni** Consultant Diabetologist Bharati Vidyapeeth (DU), Medical College

& Hospital, Sangli RSSDI Dist. Coordinator to speak on the topic "**Pharmacy updates in Diabetes management**". He conducted a very informative session and explained about the different medications used to treat diabetes which included tab. Metformin, DPP-4 Inhibitors, GLP-1 Receptor agonist, SGLTz inhibitors and Insulin he also discussed about factors affecting on medical management. The session was ended by 3:00 pm.



At 3:00 pm the 4th and last session of the day started. Ms. Jessica Mali introduced the speaker Mrs. **Dhanshree Mali** Senior Dietitian, Bharati Vidyapeeth (DU) Medical College and Hospital, Sangli her topic was **"Diet and exercises in Diabetes"**. She discussed about the what are the factors affecting the diet of the patient, symptoms of diabetes and gave food exchange list with the dietary requirements of proteins, carbohydrate and fats for children as well as adult. 




DAY - 2

The conference started with the first session of the day on the topic **"Diabetes Retinopathy and its screening".** Dr. Pravin Dani sir introduced the speaker **Dr. Ajit Limaye** HOD, Department of Optometry, Bharati Vidyapeeth (DU) Medical College and Hospital, Sangli. Dr. Ajit sir explained how eyes plays an important role in our life by providing 70% of input as a sensory organ making a human live independently. He also explained the severity of the condition by telling even a small occlusion in micro vessels can lead to complication and explained about eye screening ophthalmic assessment, surgical and medical management, and laser treatment. Session ended by 11:00 am.



Second session of the started at 11:00 am. Ms. Sairandhri patil introduced the second speaker of the day **Mrs. C. Smita Anand** Manager Nursing, Aster Aadhar Hospital, Kolhapur, who deal with the topic "**Nurses role in Diabetic Care**". She discussed about how to plan and set the goals, priority wise intervention and its implementation. It was an informative session with group involvement throughout the session. Mrs. Nilima. R. After all the session the "Plenary session was arranged on the topic Diabetic complications and its management" and the panellist were as followed



Dr. Pravin Dani Vice-Principal, BV(DU),CON, Sangli moderator of the panel discussion introduced all the panellist and gave a brief information related complications of diabetes and its types acute and chronic complication which has two more types micro vascular and macrovascular complication . Dr. Pravin Dani sir requested first panellist Dr. Rajendra Lamkhede to share his experience on complication of Diabetes. He explained hypoglycaemia as one of the complication and what are the consequences, prevention, evaluation and nurses' role. Dr. Pravin Dani sir requested second panellist **Dr. Basavant Dhudum** to share his experience on complication on one of the common and very important complication. "Diabetic ketoacidosis and hyperglycaemic hyperosmotic state". He explained about the disease condition, difference between DKA and HHS, sign and symptoms, how to identify the DKA and HHS and what is the management and different therapies used.



Dr.Pravin Dani sir now requested the next panellist **Dr. Vaishali jadhav** to discuss about the microvascular complications of diabetes. She discussed about diabetic neuropathy, diabetic nephropathy and diabetic retinopathy as microvascular complications of diabetes. She explained about prevalence of the complication, risk factors, stages, screening test and the management.



The last panellist was Dr. Nupoor Who shared her knowledge about the macrovascular disorders complications of diabetes. She explained that Brain, Heart. Peripheral vessels are mostly affected macro vessels in the body. She also discussed what are the risk factors, pathophysiology, prevalence, sign and symptoms of the diseases and pharmacological management, nursing management. She also named the medications used in management of macrovascular diseases which include Atorvastatin, Ecosprin, Aspirin, Clopidogril etc. She discussed how to diagnose the condition and 6 P of limb ischemia which are pain, pallor, paraesthesia, paralysis and persisting cold classification of foot ulcer as per SINBAD. She completed her session by 2:00 pm and ended her session with beautiful quote.



The next event was paper presentation and poster presentation and the participants were awarded with prize. Dr. Nilima Bhore ma'am appreciated all the participants for their efforts.




The conference reached to the end part where all the dignitaries were awarded with certificate for participation. Dr. Nilima ma'am motivated all the participants and gave them participation certificate.
