Parents Feedback Analysis Academic Year 2021-22

Parents Feedback Report

Overall, the average of the parents' feedback was excellent (about 43%) on academic and non-academic facilities, 38% felt it was very good, about 18% felt as good and few reported it as poor.

Admission, of their ward in this college as first preference, was rated very high by the parents (70%) and parents have provided an "Excellent" feedback rating for the admission procedure (40%) adopted by the college. Security and discipline of the college campus were also highly commended by most of the parents (42%).

Parents also rated the academic atmosphere very highly (45%), and most parents found college infrastructure adequate (40%) rated it very good. However, some also reported the infrastructure to be inadequate.

Suggestions of Parents

- There should be a parent-teacher interaction at least once in a session.
- Regular cleaning of toilets, common rooms, classrooms, labs, and college campus.
- Use of the latest technology aids in teaching (digital and smart classes).
