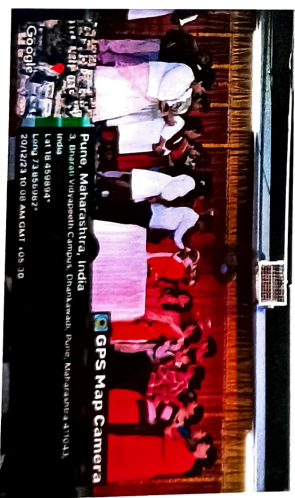
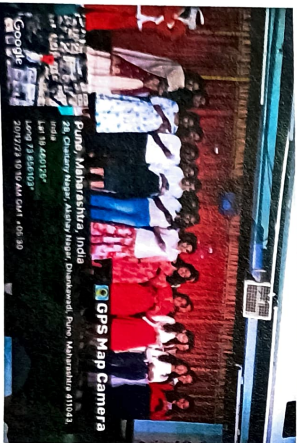
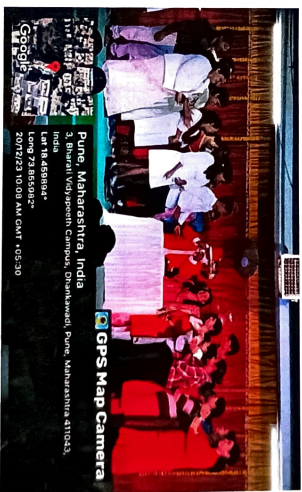
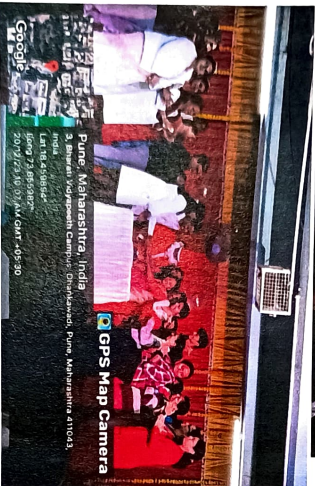
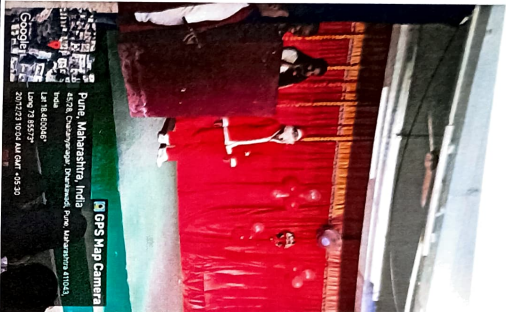
The celebration of Christmas day was conducted in Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) College of Nursing Pune on 20/12/2024.

Day 4: Angel & Devil Day

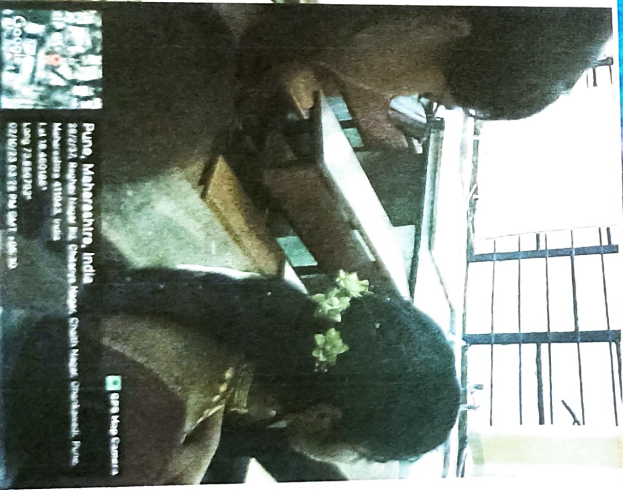
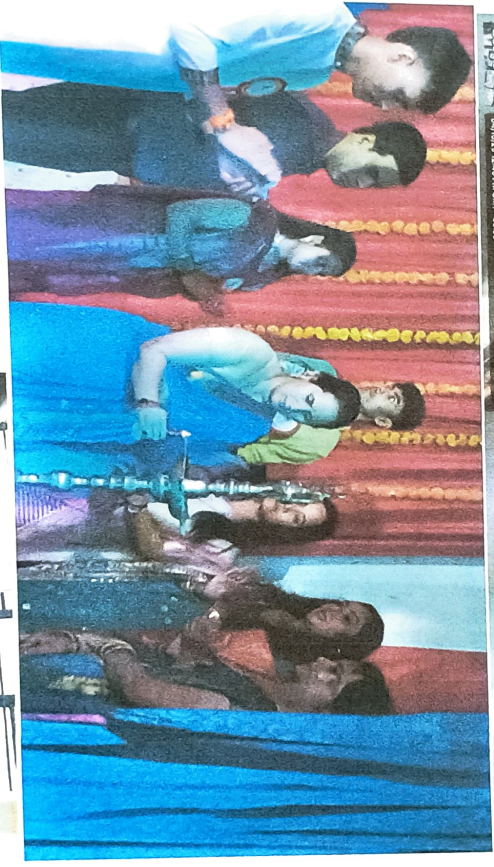
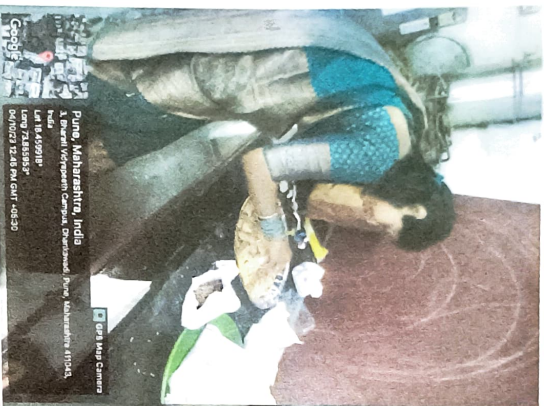

Day 5: Retro Day

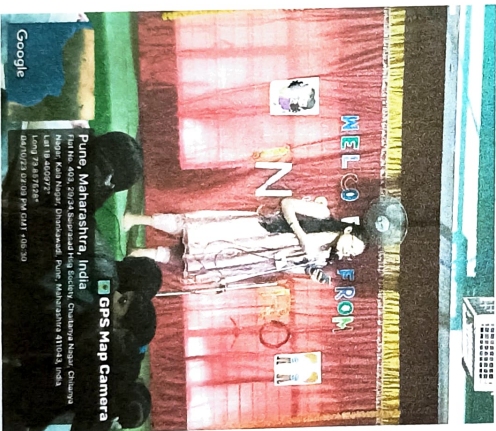

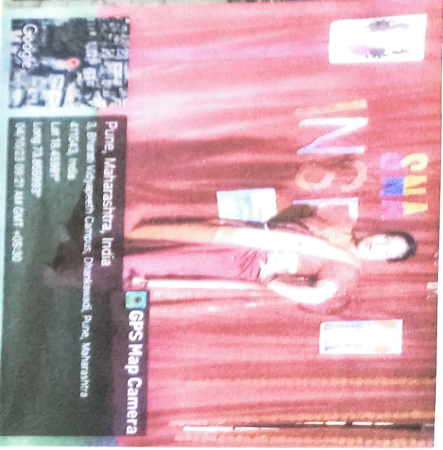


