Indian Knowledge Systems: A Tapestry of Wisdom Heritage

In an era of unprecedented global challenges like health crises, climate change, and socioeconomic disparities, the wisdom engraved in Indian Indigenous Knowledge Systems (IKS) may potentially offer a ray of hope. Due to the colonial mindset, the perception of Indian knowledge has not been good. It is often considered as a system that contains only religious beliefs and practices. While such practices are indeed a significant aspect, it is pivotal to recognize that IKS covers a range of practical knowledge. From mental, physical, and other aspects of health to holistic wellness, mathematics to astronomy, and art, aesthetics, and philosophy, IKS not only adds value to the modern understanding of these domains but also offers a range of comprehensive solutions to many contemporary problems. The sources of knowledge of various disciplines in IKS are both oral traditions and textual. Texts such as Charaka Samhita (approx. 2nd Cent BCE to 2nd Cent CE), Sushruta Samhita (approx. 6th Cent. BCE to 2nd Cent BCE), Ashtanga Hridaya (approx. 7th Cent. CE), and Bala Samhita (approx. 8th Cent. CE) are the key texts on Ayurveda. They discuss various aspects related to general principles, pathology, anatomy, therapeutics, pharmacy, and other related details. The contribution of IKS in mathematics and astronomy is also remarkable. Surya Siddhanta (approx. 4th Century CE), Aryabhatya (499 CE), and Brahmagupta (628 CE) are some of the texts about mathematics and astronomy. The text Surya Siddhanta introduces the concept of the earth's circumference and diameter, providing a remarkably accurate approximation. The concept related to planetary positions as outlined in Aryabhatya is

surprisingly similar to the modern heliocentric theory. Likewise, there are several mentions in these texts that astound us, proving that many complex topics were not only understood but scientifically explained in ancient Indian texts much before they became common knowledge in the West. There are more than 200 domains in which IKS offers a corpus of knowledge. The principles found in IKS texts are not relics of the past; they must be studied as blueprints for addressing modern issues. The challenges faced by contemporary society such as health, morality, climate change, peace, economy, governance, architecture, engineering, etc are not new. These issues have existed in various forms throughout

At the very least, we should recognize the importance of preserving the continuity of a civilization's thought to inspire and shape better solutions for today's problems. For example, Vastu Shastra, attributed to the sage Vishwakarma, provides guidelines for sustainable architecture and urban planning. These principles, which emphasize harmony with nature, are increasingly relevant as cities seek to become eco-friendly and more resilient in the face of climate change. The ancient treatise Yajñagyayurveda by Surapada

offers insights into agriculture and environmental conservation that can inform contemporary practices. In a world where environmental degradation is a pressing

issue, these ancient wisdoms can guide sustainable living and resource management.
