


Orientation :





Brief of the Project:

The Ministry of Panchayati Raj had assigned the task of preparing model GPSDP for two pilot villages to Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed University's, College of Architecture, Pune.

Villages were shortlisted by the Ministry, and BVDU-COA, Pune; by conducting data analysis of about 15 villages in ten districts in western Maharashtra based on a set of prescribed criteria.
