# **Overall: SWOT analysis of the four weeks of exchange programme**

## **Strengths:**

- First time our institute is handled the student exchange programme so it was challenging to achieve their goals.
- Proper guidance and support by the dean Dr. Nilima Bhore during the student exchange programme.
- Mentors were deeply involved in programme and achieved the learning objectives of the students within the provided time span by exposing them to the various areas.

- We react to each opportunity and offer by our university and institution with Wi-Fi facility in the institute and hostel.
- Maintained the proper communication channels between the students and mentors.
- Mentor showed patience while handling the international students.
- Hand on practice to achieve the goal of IUCD insertion, skill to improve the hearing FSH within time span.
- Maintained team spirit and achieved the goals within three weeks as scheduled.
- During the stay our campus has turned to the most attractive to the students. Hostel rooms were renovated completely with A.C.

#### Weakness:

- Students have to discuss their learning goals with the mentors frequently as their learning goals; strategy and achievement will be communicated to the mentors before preparation of their schedule.
- Midwifery practices in India and Sweden is totally different so the students should not expect the same practices as in Sweden and observe the thing patiently and suggest the changes as per their view.
- During learning phase students learnt their education in Swedish so faced difficulty in explaining the procedure during hand on experience in identifying of the instruments etc. But still we were tried to educate them the best things.

## **Opportunity:**

- It was good opportunity to be mentors of the international students.
- It was interesting to know about the midwifery practices of Sweden and new trends to improve the midwifery practices in India.
- It was eye opener for the midwives to fight for the rights, making changes in government policy to work independently and look into the ethical and legal issues as health care team members.
- The strong international collaboration and good relationships with our partner universities should be maintained and developed also in future and if possible extend a frame of such cooperation.
