RECOGNITION ORDER

20

1. Whereas in terms of Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993, **Bharti Vidyapeeth, Plot No.- 26,27, Street - Pune Satara Road, Vill. - Pune, P.O. - Dhankawadi, Teh. / Tal. - Haveli, City - Pune, Dist. - Pune - 4111043, Maharashtra (APP997)** had submitted an application to the Western Regional Committee of the NCTE on 27.09.2010 for grant of recognition to **Bharti Vidyapeeth Deemed University College of Physical Education, Plot/ Street No. 26, 27, Vill. - Dhankawadi, P.O. - Dhankawadi, Tehsil / Tal/ - Haveli, City - Pune, Dist.- Pune - 4111043, Maharashtra** for starting the M.P.Ed. Course with an annual intake of 40 students.
2. And, Whereas, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library, qualified staff, laboratory and that it fulfills such other conditions required for proper functioning of the institution for M.P.Ed. course as determined by regulations.
3. Now, Therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Bharti Vidyapeeth Deemed University College of Physical Education, Plot/ Street No. 26, 27, Vill. - Dhankawadi, P.O. - Dhankawadi, Tehsil / Tal/ - Haveli, City - Pune, Dist.- Pune - 4111043, Maharashtra (APP997)** for starting the M.P.Ed. Course of Elementary level of 2 Years with an annual intake of 40 students from the academic session 2014-2015, in view of the Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 13/12/2012 in W.P. (Civil) 276/2012.
4. Further, the institution is required to comply with all post-recognition conditions enumerated from Clause 8(11) to Clause 8(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
5. The society sponsoring the institution shall transfer and vest the title of the land and building in the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of this order and submit the documents to the Western Regional Committee. However, in case the society fails to do so due to local laws or rules or bye-laws, it shall intimate in writing with documentary evidence of its inability to do so.
6. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
7. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
8. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its Official website.
