

4) Camps conducted at Kai Sitaram Aabaji Prathmik Vidyalaya, Bibwewadi (5/7/2022)

4) Vijay Mukund Athavale Vidyalaya, Nasrapur (14/1/2020)

The teams arrived to the location at 10 am and the camp was inaugurated with a welcome speech by the HM of the school. School Students attended the medical camp and benefitted. It was the best camp as not only the students were receptive of the instructions but also involved as participants. Few of the patients were referred by the doctors for further treatment at Bharati Vidyapeeth Dental College and Hospital, Pune. Nasrapur, being a rural village, lacked optimal dental care. The interns understood the mindset of the students and made them understand in an activity friendly way. The volunteers played a vital role in making this camp successful with their dedication in serving people

6) Kothrud Bus depot (16/1/2020)

Dental camp was conducted at the Kothrud Bus depot for the bus drivers to ensure dental hygiene awareness. The Interns spoke about the importance of oral and dental care and explained in detail about the root cause of the dental and oral health problems. A total of 107 bus drivers were examined the students further briefed about how to avoid toothache related problems. The bus drivers also had a question and answer session in Marathi with the doctors to resolve their queries based on dental hygiene. As the Bus Drivers have long hectic days of travelling and they are bound to chew tobacco, the interns made them understand the repercussions which made them realize their mistake. They gave referral slips for those who needed further treatment. The camp turned out to be very beneficial for the interns as well as it was a day of learning about the difficulties that bus driver's face.

7) Bharati Vidyapeeth Kanya Prashala, Pune (27th- 29th august 2019)

The camp was conducted in girls' schools to make the students aware of dental hygiene. A total of 523 students were examined. It included dental awareness talk, educating students about common dental ailments — especially stressing on tooth decay and gum diseases — and the measures used to prevent them. The students were made aware about the eating patterns and food choices which can lead to tooth decay.
