

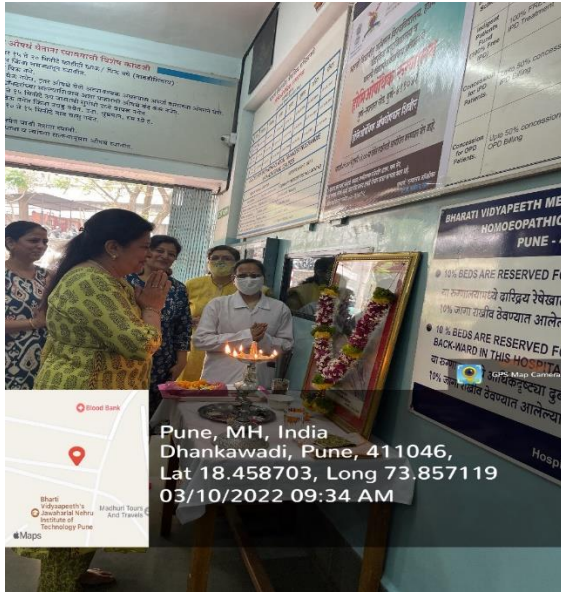

Urban Camp for Female complaints & Kidney diseases

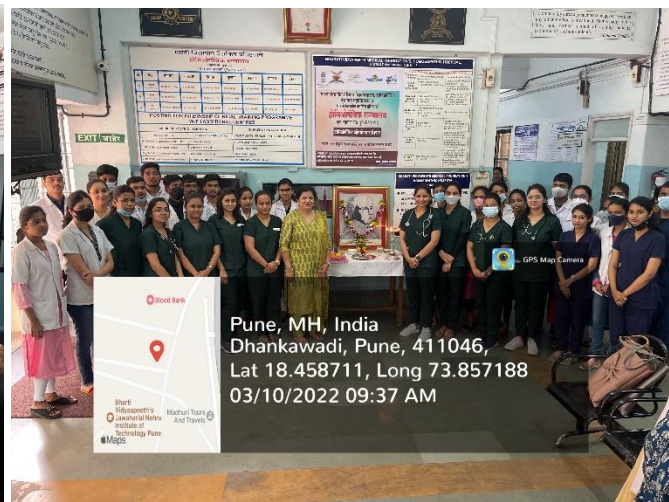

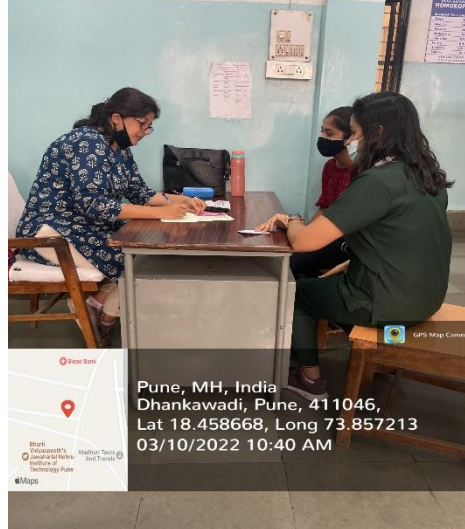
