REPORT OF THE EVENT

The Post-Graduate Department of Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) Homoeopathic Medical College, Pune organized the three day “**Founder Chancellor, Hon’ble Dr. Patangraoji Kadam Post Graduate Homoeopathic National Research Conclave/Webinar 2020**”.

This Three day Research Conclave was organized with the sole purpose of providing a centre stage to the students to learn and present the research conducted by them and also to gain knowledge relating to application of research and statistics in the field of homoeopathy through the various lectures conducted.

Over the years almost all our P.G. scholars have attended various conferences curiously on the subject of improving the Homoeopathic fraternity in terms of Research. They have published papers in UGC recognized journals and also participated in conferences with Paper/Poster presentations. This year, due to the current pandemic of CoVID-19, the conclave which was originally to be held in the month of April 2020 had to be postponed and was finally organized on the 7th, 8th and 9th September 2020 in the form of a webinar through Microsoft Teams app. We had organized this research conclave to boost the Post Graduate and the Ph.D. scholars to prove themselves and improve the standards of research in the field of Homoeopathy.

DAY 1: The conclave began with a lamp lighting ceremony by Dr. Arun B. Jadhav, Principal, Bharati Vidyapeeth Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Pune in the virtual presence of all the dignitaries. This was followed by a welcome speech by Dr. Anita S. Patil, Dean, FOH and PG-Coordinator, Bharati

Vidyapeeth Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Pune. It was vibrant and enthusiastic and helped in setting up the tone for the conclave.

This was followed by the Principal Address in which he guided the students for the need to re-search and conduct baseline studies to improve the basis of thinking to generate the topics for research. Emphasis was also given to the collaborative and inter-disciplinary activities of research. All the dignitaries were then introduced and felicitated.

Following that, the chief guests addressed the crowd. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Dr. Manikrao Madhavrao Salunkhe, Bharati (Deemed to be) University, Pune shared his views of such a high quality conclave and expressed his views on the need of inter-disciplinary collaborative works in chemistry and homoeopathy and how the practical knowledge in one field of science can be helpful in uplifting another field of science.

Hon'ble Dr. Anil Khurana, Deputy Director General, CCRH emphasized on the necessity of research based advancement in homoeopathy by the students and talked about the scope of research for homoeopathic researchers in the present state. He also shared his views on collaborative work and the importance of sharing knowledge with one another and also shared his views on participating in the far reach of the conclave from next time onwards.

This was followed by a vote of thanks from Dr. Tejas P. Gosavi, M.D., Ph.D. scholar, Asso. Prof of Dept. of Pharmacy, BVDUHMC, Pune.

Post inauguration, the session started with lectures on BIOINFORMATICS by DR. SHAMIM SHAIKH which detailed the application of correct interpretation of knowledge of medicine and gene expression etc.

This was followed by a lecture by DR. PRAKASH DOKE on PROTOCOL DEVELOPMENT which answered the questions regarding development of protocols and operating procedures in order to start a research.

Post lunch, the session opened with the e-Poster Presentation competition where participants from all over India as well as scholars of Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) Homoeopathic Medical College, 12th Batch Post Graduate Students participated.

DAY 2: The session started with a lecture by MR. KARAMCHAND PATIL on MEDICAL STATISTICS which shed a light on the application of statistical analysis and various aspect of research.

After this lecture, we observed a session by DR. ANIKET V. MALI about TRANSLATIONAL RESEARCH which touched on the subject of various aspect of drug action, relationship in correspondence to pharmaceuticals.

After a short break, the e-Poster Presentation competition commenced where participants presented their evidence based research work.

DAY 3: On the last day, the session started with a lecture about PUBLICATION WRITING by DR. JAGAJIT SAHU which helped to unravel the complexity of publication of any research article and various view regarding to the publication.

Then, e-poster competition for the topics of evidence based medicine and role of homoeopathy in CoVID-19 commenced.

After a break, we commenced towards the valedictory function of the 3 day research conclave with a speech by Dr. Anita S. Patil, Dean, FOH and PG-Coordinator, Bharati Vidyapeeth Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Pune which was followed by a brief report of the conclave by Dr. Arun B Jadhav, Principal, BVDUHMC, and Pune. This Speech was followed by few words from the sponsor of the conclave, AIHSAYA

(All India Homoeopathic Students and Youth Association) organization. After this, we observed speeches & Announcement of winners by the Judges' panel.

This was succeeded by a Vote of thanks by the Organizing Committee. Then the Research Conclave was concluded by Dr. Anita S. Patil.

The conclave was attended by over 500 attendees from various colleges and institutions all over India from 13 states like Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Delhi, Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal and Maharashtra and over 40 enthusiastic participants for the e-poster competition with 35 presenting their evidence based researches and 8 presenters about COVID 19 research.
