CIRCULAR

The Joint Director (Higher Education), Government of Maharashtra vide his letter No. Jt.Dir./Hig.Edu./Pune Div./Reg.cla. /Pvt./Sankirna/2021/471 dated 04/02/2021 conveyed that Higher Education Institutions in Maharashtra can start for physical classes from 15th February, 2021.

Accordingly, the authorities of the university have decided that all the constituent colleges/institutes should commence the classroom teaching from 15th February, 2021. It may kindly be noted that all Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) conveyed earlier should be adopted.

Secondly, the suggestions and guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission dated 5th November, 2020 should be implemented strictly.

All the Principals/Directors are requested to refer to the website of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, University Grants Commission and Ministry of Human Resource Development for the different guidelines given by them, to contain the spread of COVID 19 and to ensure the safety of the students and the staff.

It was suggested that the institutes/colleges may start with 50% students strength. The planning may be done at the college level about implementation of the suggestion.

Above all, it is very important that the college should not be the source of spreading the COVID 19 amongst the students as well as the staff members.
